WATER ACT 1989

I, Patrick John McNamara, as Minister administering the Water Act 1989, make the following Order:

TRANSFER OF WORKS TO THE GOULBURN VALLEY REGION WATER AUTHORITY ORDER 1997

Citation

 This Order is called the Transfer of Works to the Goulburn Valley Region Water Authority Order 1997.

Enabling Powers

 This Order is made under the powers conferred by Division 2 of Part 6 of the Water Act 1989 and all other available powers.

Date of Effect

This Order takes effect on and from 1 September 1997.

Definitions

4. In this Order

"Act" means the Water Act 1989;

"Authority" means the Goulburn Valley Region Water Authority which was constituted by an Order dated 20 February 1994 under the Act and published in the Victoria Government Gazette on 24 February 1994.

Appointment of the Goulburn Valley Region Water Authority

On and from the date on which this Order takes effect all the works operated by the Murrindindi Shire Council in performing its functions and exercising its powers under the Local Government Act 1989 in respect of the Molesworth Water Supply system are transferred to the Authority.

Pre-requisites for Making this Order

- 6. (a) This is an Order referred to in Section 98 (3) (a) of the Act;
 - (b) Under Section 98 (4) (a) of the Act, I have agreed to the terms and conditions for the transfer made by this Order with the Authority and the Murrindindi Shire Council;
 - (c) Under Section 98 (4) (b) of the Act, I am satisfied that appropriate provisions have been made in relation to the disposition of the works, the rights and liabilities of the Murrindindi Shire Council and the manner of repayment of any money borrowed in respect of the works;

- (d) Under Section 100 (2) (a) of the Act, the affected Authority and the Murrindindi Shire Council have applied to me for this Order to be made; and
- (e) Under Section 100 (2) (b) of the Act, I have consulted with the Minister administering the Local Government Act 1989 as a Council is affected.
