Wildlife (Closure of Areas to Hunting) Notice No. 1/1997

I, Marie Tehan, Minister for Conservation and Land Management, make the following Notice: Dated 11 March 1997

WILDLIFE (CLOSURE OF AREAS TO HUNTING) NOTICE No. 1/1997

1. Title

This Notice may be cited as the Wildlife (Closure of Areas to Hunting) Notice No. 1/1997.

2. Objective

The objective of this Notice is to prohibit absolutely the taking, destroying or hunting of any kind or species of wildlife in any of the areas of Victoria specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3 or 4 below during the period commencing on Saturday 15 March 1997 and ending on Monday 9 June 1997 (both dates inclusive).

3. Authorising provision

This Notice is made under section 86 of the Wildlife Act 1975.

4. Hunting of wildlife prohibited

The taking, destroying or hunting of any kind or species of wildlife is prohibited absolutely-

- (a) in the area described in Schedule 1 below; and
- (b) in the area described in Schedule 2 below; and
- (c) in the area described in Schedule 3 below; and
- (d) in the area described in Schedule 4 below-

during the period commencing on Saturday 15 March 1997 and ending on Monday 9 June 1997 (both dates inclusive).

5. Penalty


Any person who contravenes this Notice is guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty not exceeding 25 penalty units.

SCHEDULE 1

The area within 800 metres of Wool Wool Rocks being the rocks near the shore of that part of Lake Corangamite that is located in the Shire of Colac-Otway.

That part of Lake Connewarre and adjoining land shown by heavy border on the plan hereunder.

Lake Elingamite, south of the Township of Elingamite North in the Parish of Elingamite.


