ORDER DECLARING A RESTRICTED AREA FOR THE CONTROL OF FIRE BLIGHT

I, Patrick McNamara, Minister for Agriculture and Resources, make the following declaration and specification of prohibitions, restrictions and requirements.

1. *Objective*

The objective of this Order is to restrict the movement of plants and plant products and to require persons to take any other actions which may be required to prevent the spread of the exotic disease fire blight.

2. *Authorising Provision*

This Order is made under section 20 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995**.

3. *Definition*

In this Order -

“Fire blight” means the exotic disease fire blight caused by the bacterium *Erwinia amylovora*.

4. *Declaration of restricted area for the control of fire blight*

All the land within the Melbourne City Council bounded by the southern side of the Yarra River, St Kilda Road, Toorak Road and Punt Road is hereby declared to be a restricted area for the purposes of controlling the spread of the exotic disease fire blight.

5. Prohibitions, restrictions and requirements

- (1) The removal of any of the genera of plants described in the Schedule to this Order from the restricted area declared in clause 4 is prohibited, unless the person is authorised to do so under a permit issued under section 21 of the **Plant Health and Plant Products Act 1995** by an inspector appointed under section 51 and complies with the conditions set out in the permit.
- (2) All plants found to be affected by fire blight must be either removed or pruned to remove the affected part of the plant or treated with a chemical approved for the control of fire blight as directed by an inspector.
