### Planning and Environment Act 1987 MONASH PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment L29

The Minister for Planning and Local Government has approved Amendment L29 to the Monash Planning Scheme.

The amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The amendment applies to land known as the Brandon Park Shopping Centre, corner of Ferntree Gully and Springvale Road, Mulgrave. The Amendment deletes references to "gross leasable floor area" substituting the term "leasable floor area" in Clause 115-6 of the Monash Planning Scheme. The amendment also corrects an anomaly in the Clause by identifying other land uses which presently exist at the Shopping Centre.
