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

WEST WIMMERA SHIRE COUNCIL Proposed Local Law Use of Common Seal Local Law No. 4

Notice is given that West Wimmera Shire Council ("Council") proposes to make the Use of Common Seal Local Law No. 4 pursuant to the Local Government Act 1989 ("the Act").

The purposes of the Proposed Local Law

- to regulate the use of the Common Seal of Council;
- prohibit unauthorised use of the Common Seal or any device resembling the Common Seal.

The general purport of the proposed Local Law is that it:

 requires that the Common Seal of Council be used only with the authority of Council;

- requires the Chief Executive Officer to ensure the security of the Common Seal of Council;
- requires that where the Common Seal is affixed to a document, the document must be signed by at least two Councillors and the Chief Executive Officer:
- creates an offence for any person to use Council's Common Seal without authority;
- creates an offence for any person to use any replica of Council's Common Seal without authority.

A copy of the proposed Local Law may be inspected at or obtained from the Shire Office, 49 Elizabeth Street, Edenhope, or the Kaniva District Office, 25 Baker Street, Kaniva.

Any person affected by the proposed Local Law may make a written submission relating to it to Council. Submissions received by Council within 14 days of the publication of this notice will be considered in accordance with Section 223 of the Act. Any person requesting that he or she be heard in support of a written submission is entitled to appear before a meeting of Council either personally or by a person acting on his or her behalf and will be notified of the time and the date of hearing.

Submissions should be lodged at 49 Elizabeth Street, Edenhope, or 25 Baker Street, Kaniva, or posted to Council at P.O. Box 201, Edenhope 3318. All interested persons are encouraged to acquaint themselves with the proposed Local Law.






