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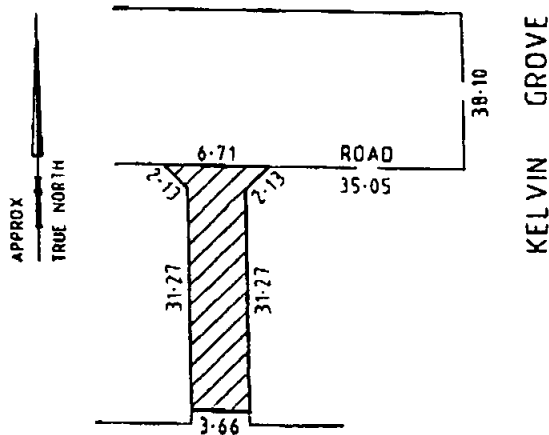

ROSEBERRY AVENUE**

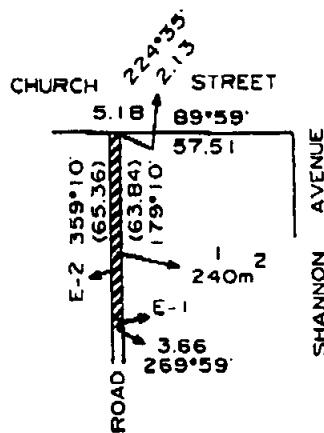

PLAN OF DISCONTINUED ROAD



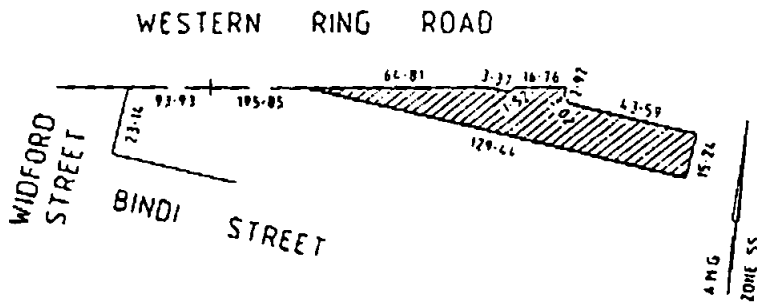

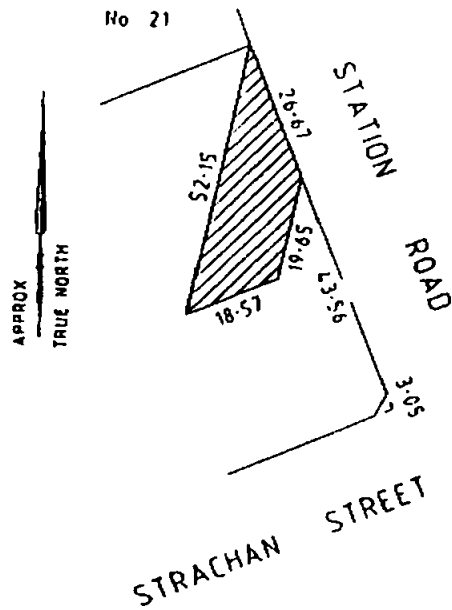

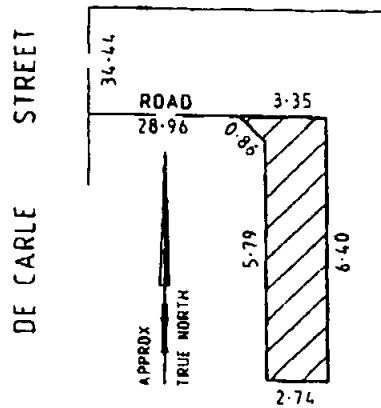
PLAN OF DISCONTINUED ROAD

PLAN OF DISCONTINUED ROAD

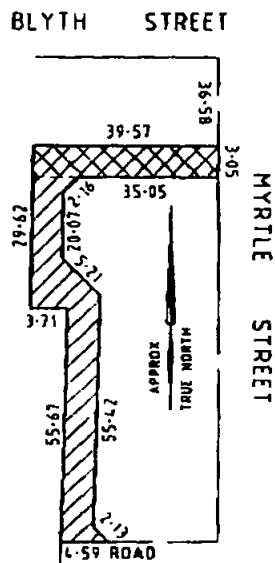

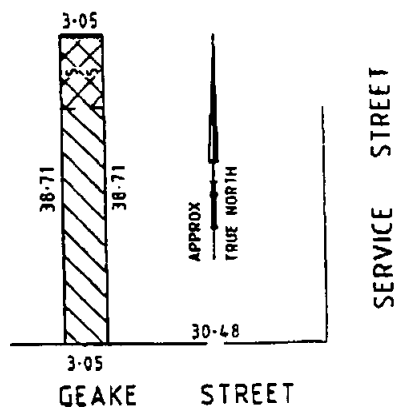

PLAN OF DISCONTINUED ROAD

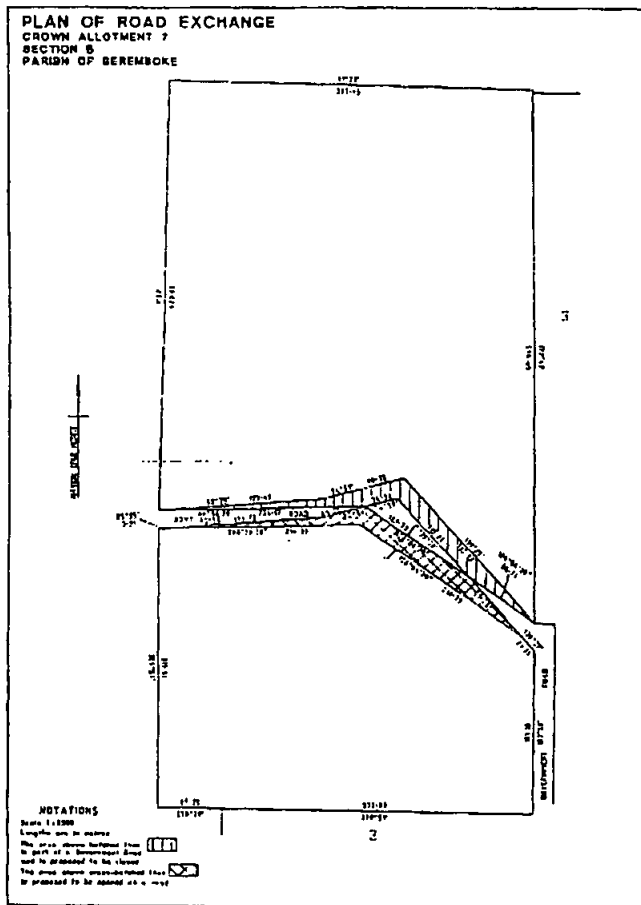

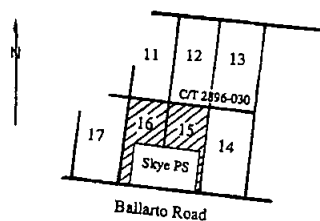
