THE following descriptions of GRANTS OF LAND, with the names of the persons to whom they were originally promised, or by whom they are now claimed, are published for general information, in order that all parties concerned may have an opportunity of correcting any errors or omissions that may have been made inadvertently.

It is requested that within three months from the present date, the particulars required by the Government Notice of the 1st October, 1838, may be accurately furnished to this Office, namely,

Surname, and all Christian Names of the person in whose favor the Deed is to be prepared, written at full length, his residence, and the intended name of the property.

Also, (if required in any name but that of the original Promisee) the grounds of the claim, and a letter from the said Promisee, if living, and from all intermediate Assigns, if any, giving his and their consent and sanction thereto, and witnessed either by a Magistrate, or by a Solicitor of the Supreme Court.

If these be duly furnished, and satisfactory, and if no caveat be lodged, or other cause of uncertainty appear, the Deeds will be prepared accordingly, as soon as possible after the expiration of the stated period of three months.

If the required particulars be not furnished within that period, or if a caveat be lodged, or other cause of uncertainty arise, which cannot be satisfactorily determined by the Government, the case will be referred to the Commissioners of Claims, and the parties subjected to the expense of that proceeding.

#### COUNTY UNNAMED.

433. WILLIAM H. BROUGHTON, 1280, Twelve hundred and eighty acres, parish unnamed, at Buroowa; bounded on the north by a line west 146 chains, commencing at Buroowa River, being 1 mile south of the south boundary of Fisher's grant; on the west by a line south 80 chains; on the south by a line east 162 chains; and on the east by Buroowa River.

Authorised by Sir Ralph Darling on the 4th September, 1829, and possession given on 4th February, 1830, as an additional grant.

Quit-rent £10 13s. 4d. sterling per annum, commencing 1st January, 1831.

#### ARGYLE.

434. HUMPHREY THORN, 320, Three hundred and twenty acres, parish unnamed, near Goulburn; bounded on the east by a line south 80 chains, commencing at the junction of John Thorn's south boundary; bearing east with William Bradley's 1000 acres purchase west boundary; on the south by a line west 40 chains; on the west by a line north 80 chains; and on the north by a line east 40 chains.

Authorised by Sir Salph Darling on 24th May, 1830, and possession given on 30th May, 1834, as an additional grant, being in lieu of 60 acres near Goulburn, of which he received possession on 18th September, 1828, but subsequently ceded to the Veterans; being also the land of which he was authorised to take possession on 24th July, 1833.

Quit-rent 10s. sterling per annum, commencing 1st January, 1834, being the amount chargeable on the former grant of 60 acres.

435. JOHN BRAY, 640, Six hundred and forty acres, parish unnamed, near Pegar, Upper Wollondilly; bounded on the west by a line north 80 chains,

commencing 2 miles east of the south-east corner of W. Hodges' 250 acres; on the north by a line east 80 chains; on the east by a line south 80 chains; and on the south by a line west 80

Authorised by Sir Ralph Darling, on the 20th February, 1827, and possession given on the 9th June following, in lieu of 60 acres originally ordered for him by Governor Macquurie.

mencing 1st January, 1835.

436. John Passmore, 100, One hundred acres, parish of Towrang, at Darby Murray's Flat; bounded on the west by a line south 53 chains, commencing at the north-east corner of J. Cole's grant; on the south by a line east 18 chains; on the east by a line north 57 chains; and 50 links; and on the north by the Wollondilly River.

Promised by Sir Ralph Darling on 26th June, 1829, and possession authorised on 18th Septem-

ber, 1830.

Quit-rent one farthing for ever, the promisee being a disbanded soldier of the New South Wales

Royal Veteran Corps.

Mrs. Janet Templeton, 2560, Two thousand five hundred and sixty acres, parish unnamed, at Couchipinolong, on Mulwarree Plains; bounded on the north by a line east 224 chains, commencing at Paton's south-west corner on the Mulwarree chain of ponds; on the east by a line south 120 chains; on the south by a line west 190 chains; and on the west by Mulwarree chain of ponds to the south-west corner of Paton's land as aforesaid.

Authorised by Sir Ralph Darling on the 11th August, 1831, and possession given on the 15th October following, as a primary grant.

#### BATHURST.

WILLIAM AUGUSTUS STEELE, 1600, Sixteen hundred acres, parish unnamed, near the Three Brothers, commencing at the north-west corner, 2 miles south, and one mile east from the southeast corner of George Cheshire's 640 acres purchase: and bounded on the west by a line south 200 chains; on the south by a line east 80 chains; and on the by a line north 200 chains; and on the north by a line west 80 chains to the northwest corner aforesaid.

Promised by Sir George Gipps on 18th April, 1838, and possession given on the 7th August following, as an additional grant under the regulations of 27th June, 1837.

Quit-rent £10 sterling per annum, commencing

Ist January, 1839.

Authorised by Sir Ralph Darling on the 17th September, 1827, and possession given on the 20th March, 1828, to Mrs. Fennell as a primary grant, being the quantity promised by Sir Thomas Brisbane to her husband, the late Mr. John Fennell.

Authorised by Governor Macquarie, on the 31st March, 1821, as a small Grant.
