HIS Excellency the GOVERNOR is pleased to direct that the general objects of the following Bill, now under consideration of the Legislative Council, be published for general information.

No. 1—"A Bill for further facilitating proceedings by and against all Banking and other Companies in the Colony, entitled to sue and be

sued in the name of their Chairman, Secretary, or other Officer."

Whereas several Acts have passed the Legislative Council of this Colony, for enabling Joint Stock Companies to sue and be sued in the name of their Chairman, or other Managing Officer, it is proposed by this Bill, to make it compulsory on such Companies to supply any vacancy occurring in the Office of Chairman or Manager, within one month thereafter, on pain of forfeiting all privileges conferred by such Acts.
