CLAIMS TO LEASES OF CROWN LANDS,

BEYOND THE SETTLED DISTRICTS.

BLIGH DISTRICT.

HIS Excellency the GOVERNOR directs it to be notified, for the information of all persons interested, that in pursuance of Her Majesty's Order in Council, of 9th March, 1847, the under-mentioned persons have demanded Leases of the several Runs of Crown Land, particularised in connexion with their respective names.

Persons who object to any of these claims, either wholly or in part, should lodge caveats at this Office within two months from the present date, specifying the Lands to which their objections extend, and the grounds on which their objections are based.

It is to be distinctly understood, that the Government does not pledge itself to the issue of a Lease in any case until due enquiry has been made into the validity of the claim, and whether or not it may be necessary to reserve any portion of the Land claimed, for any of the public purposes contemplated in the Order in Council.

Brown Andrew.
Name of Run—Cuigan.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—150 Cattle,
3,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by the Castloreagh River ; on the north by the Cuttubuttu station ; on the west by ranges dividing it from Mr. Rouse's run ; and on the south by Mr. Walker's run of Biambil.

No. 2.

Brown Andrew.
Name of Run—Tooraweanah.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by a range dividing it from Mr. Walker's run of Wallumburawang ; on the north by the Tunderburn Run ; on the west by the Mogurndon run ; on the south by Bennett's station, Wulluminanii.

No. 3.

Name of Run—Tunderburn.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by the Wullumbungle Mountain ; on the north by an iron bark range ; on the west by Mogie Melon Run ; and on the south by the Tooraweanah Run.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—640 Cattle.

Commencing at a waterhole named Tootalbung in the Castlereagh River, and bounded on the east by that river; on the north by Teilby's run; on the west by scrub; and on the south by Jude's run.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—640 Cattle.

Commencing 2 miles above a waterhole, named Wallunderry, in the Castlereagh River, and bounded on the west by that river; on the south by Jude's run; on the east by scrubs; and on the north by Teilby's run.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by the Tooraweanah run; on the north by the Beery run; on the west by a Myall scrub; and on the south by Bennett's run.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by the Tunderburn run; on the north by Teilby's and Cowell's runs; on the west by a Myall scrub; and on the south by the Mogie Melon station.

Name of Run—Tahrone.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—640 Cattle.

Commencing at a point 1 mile above Tahrone waterhole, in the Castlereagh River, and bounded on the east by that river; on the south by Tindall's Run; on the west by Lawson and Baley's run; and on the north by McRea's run.

Name of Run—Cuttbullah.
Estimated Area—1,600 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by the Castlereagh River; on the north by the Spring Creek dividing it from Mr. Lawson's run of Mobillah; on the west by iron bark ranges; and on the south by the Caigan run.

No. 10.

Bettington James B.
Name of Run—Turawandic.
Estimated Area—15,360 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—3,000 Sheep.

The run commences at a point on the east bank of the Castlereagh River, joining Mr. Cox's run, and is bounded on the north by a line easterly 4

miles, then south 5 miles, then by a line west separating it from Mr. Lawson's run about 4 miles, to the river; then about 3 miles by the River, which it then crosses and is bounded by a line westerly 2 miles dividing it from Mr. Dawson's run, then by a line northerly 2 miles, and lastly by a line westerly, dividing it from Mr. Cox's run, to the commencing point on the river, including the stations known as Tarrawandic and Porpalgundri.

Estimated Area—19,200 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—5,000 Sheep.

This run commences about 1 mile south of Ulomogo station, and is bounded by lines first bearing north-westerly about 6 miles, then north-easterly about 5 miles, then south-easterly about 6 miles, and last south-westerly about 5 miles to the commencing point, including the places known as Ulomogo, Moongeree, Dumoggo, and Yarra.

Estimated Area—30,720 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—1,000 Cattle.

The run commences on Turidgerec Creek, on the east side of the Turidgerec station, and is bounded towards the north-west by that creek downwards 8 miles, and then by lines first bearing south-westerly about 6 miles, then south-easterly about 8 miles, and thence north-easterly about 6 miles to the point of commencement, including the station known as Turidgerec.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

This run commences near a station called Ballaboomi, and on the east side thereof, and is bounded by lines first bearing south-westerly 4 miles, or thereabouts, thence north-westerly 10 miles, passing to the southward of Colga Hill, thence north-easterly about 4 miles, and lastly south-easterly about 10 miles to the commencing point, including the stations known as Bucklenbaa, Ballaboomi, and Merrinan.

Bounded on the north by James Walker's station, Wallambrawang; on the south by John Merrit's station, Erringerong; on the east by James Walker's station, Wantobadgory; on the west by Andrew Brown's station, Tooroowenna.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—400 Cattle, 960 Sheep.

Bounded on the north by a line east and west dividing it from John Jude's station, Amatrete, on

the Castlereagh River; on the south by a line east and west dividing it from Mr. Lowe's station, Yalengreen, same river; on the east by a line north and south 10 miles from the right bank of same river; on the west by a line north and south 5 miles from the left bank of the same river.

Name of Run—Pullingarwarina.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—500 Cattle.

Bounded by, and on the right bank of the Macquarie River, 5 miles north of John Jude's station.

No. 17.

Name of Run—Tacklebang.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—1,117 Sheep.

Bounded on the north by James Bishop's station, Collingili, on the Marthagai Creek; on the south by Lowe's station, on the Marthagai; on the east by Robert Bennet's station, Curban; on the west by G. M. Lowe's station, on the Bandanar Creek.

No. 18.

Blackman William.

Name of Run—Bulorora.

Estimated Area—48,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—1,000 Cattle.

Bounded on the south by the licensed station of Andrew Brown, known as Tyrone; on the east by the licensed station of Mr. Fitzsimmons, known as Taramdown; on the north by the licensed station of James Evans, known as Bringlegully; and on the west by the licensed station of Christopher M'Crae, known as Moalma.

No. 19.

Blackman William.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—600 Cattle.

Bounded on the south by my own licensed station, known as Pierpier; on the east by the Moalma Creek; on the north by John Blackman's station, known as Noogla; and on the west by pine and sand ridges.

No. 20.

Blackman William.

Name of Run—Gidgingbilla.

Estimated Area—32,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—900 Cattle.

Bounded on the south by my own licensed station, known as Bulorora; on the east by James Evans' station, known as Bunglogully; on the north by John Blackman's run, known as Nugal; and on the west by M'Crae's run on Bundy Creek.

No. 21.

Blackman William.

Name of Run—Piorpier.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—2,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the south by my own station, known as Ningear; on the east by the Moalma

Creek; on the north by my own licensed station, Gungalma; and on the west by pine and sandy ridges.

No. 22.

Bayly N. P.

Name of Run—Mianguillia.

Estimated Area—32,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the north by the Botheroe, the licensed station of Mr. Vincent; on the east by Cooler Ranges; on the west by the Mumbedah, a licensed station of Mr. Vincent; and on the south by Cooler ranges.

No. 23.

Boyd Benjamin.

Name of Run—Gobolion.

Estimated Area—30,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—600 Cattle.

Joining the eastern boundary running along the County of Bligh; bounded on the south by the Macquarie River; north by the Bodongora; west by Gyalma.

No. 24.

Blackman John.

Name of Run—Nengal.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—1,000 Cattle.

Commencing at the junction of the Merimbar Creek at a place called Tullorah, and running in a south-westerly direction along the Big River for about 12 miles to a point called Polly Brown's Pond; bounded on the north by unoccupied land covered with scrub; on the south by the station Gungalman, in the possession of William Blackman; on the west by Euroka, Mr. Cornish's station; and the east by the Big River aforesaid.

No. 25.

Bishop James.

Name of Run—Cullengally.

Estimated Area—5½ Miles Square.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—500 Cattle, or 4,000 Sheep.

Bounded by the Martha Guy Creek on the west; Crown Lands on the east; Bennet's station on the south called Tugglebung; on the north by Rouse's station, Urobla.

No. 26.

Bayly Henry.

Name of Run—Bald Ridge.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—600 Cattle.

Bounded on the west by the Castlereagh River; on the east by Crown Lands; on the south by a licensed station of Mr. Novillo's; on the north by the licensed stations of William Lawson, senior, called Didgala and Gillalambie.

No. 27.

Cox Edward.

Name of Run—Ulamambri.

Estimated Area—19,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—300 Cattle, 4,000 Sheep.

Situate on the south-east side of the Castlereagh River, commencing quarter of a mile to the northward of an artesian spring, and extending down the said river to a ridge about a mile to the

north-east of Bettington's Toorawydy Creek, back to a dry creek called Blorwolgundy; thence by Terrawandi Creek to a ridge about a mile north of Hale's hut, at Undulerry; thence to the southern point of Ulamanbri or Cox's Creek, which creek then divides Halo's Perolawa station from Ulamanbri; on the north by a line back from the river about east south-east.

No. 28.

Cox Edward.

Name of Run—Urabrible.

Estimated Area—13,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Situate on the north-western side of the Castlereagh River, commencing about a quarter of a mile above a natural artesian spring, and extending down the river to the junction of Urabrible Creek, dividing it from Monbla, distance computed at about $5\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the two points on the river.

No. 29.

Cornish Edward Brooking.

Name of Run—Terramungamine.

Estimated Area—25,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Commencing at a box tree marked on four sides, on the bank of the Macquarie River, 1 mile and 40 chains above Belargibil, and bounded on the west by a line bearing north 10 degrees west, extending 5 miles over undulating forest country, dividing this land from the adjacent land in the occupation of Messrs. Samuel; on the north by a line bearing east 6 miles over undulating scrubby country, dividing this run from unavailable Crown Land; on the east by a line bearing south 11 degrees east, extending 2 miles and 45 chains over ridgy and scrubby country; again on the north by a line bearing east 16 degrees north sixty-five chains over hilly country; on the north-east by a line bearing east 26 degrees south extending 1 mile and 30 chains over undulating forest country; again on the north by a line bearing east 16 degrees north, extending 2 miles and 10 chains over hilly country, which last four boundary lines divide this run from adjacent lands in the occupation of Mr. Maughan; again on the east by a line bearing south 9 degrees east, extending 4 miles and 60 chains over forest country; on the south by a line bearing west, extending 4 miles over undulating scrubby country to a Commissioner's marked tree on the bank of the Macquarie River, which two last boundary lines divide this run from adjacent lands in the occupation of Mr. Dulhunty; and on the south by the Macquarie River to the point of commencement. The length and general direction of these boundary lines being given with reasonable certainty.

No. 30.

Cornish Edward Brooking.

Name of Run—Burway, (Gumalgadino.)

Estimated Area—39,800 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—800 Cattle or equivalent number of Sheep.

Commencing at a point on the bank of the Macquarie River immediately below the northern declivity of a ridge situated about 2 (miles?) above the Burway hut; bounded on the south-east by a line

bearing east 41 degrees north, extending $7\frac{1}{2}$ miles over undulating forest land, being the boundary line between this run and the adjacent land occupied by Messrs. Samuel; on the north-west by a line bearing north 33 degrees west, extending 6 miles and 70 chains over forest land, dividing this run partly from Emogandry run and partly from unavailable Crown Lands; then by a line bearing west 17 degrees north 6 miles and 40 chains over country partly scrubby and partly open, dividing this run from the adjacent lands occupied in part by Mr. Maughan and in part by Mr. Dulhunty; on the north-west by a line bearing west 44 degrees south, extending 4 miles over a flat country densely scrubby, to a marked tree on the bank of the Macquarie River, about 60 chains above Gigin, being the dividing line between this run and the adjacent land occupied by Mr. Lawson; and on the south-west by the Macquarie River to the point of commencement. The lengths and general directions of these boundary lines being given with reasonable certainty.

No. 31.

Cornish Edward Brooking.

Name of Run—Emogandry.

Estimated Area—32,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Commencing at a marked tree on the bank of the Cobacca Creek, 3 miles below Cobacca hut, bounded on the north-west by a line bearing east 35 degrees north extending 12 miles over densely scrubby country to a marked tree near the waterhole at Kickabul hut, dividing this run in part from the adjacent lands, occupied by Mr. Maughan, and in part from unavailable lands; on the east by a line bearing south extending 4 miles over barren forest land, dividing this run from unavailable land; on the north-east by a line bearing west 35 degrees south, extending 10 miles over barren forest and scrubby land, dividing this run from unavailable land and partly from adjacent land occupied by Mr. Maughan; on the south by a line bearing nearly west, extending about 4 miles over forest land to the south-east corner of the Burway run, occupied by this applicant, dividing this run from unavailable land; on the south-west by a line bearing north 33 degrees west, extending about 2 miles over forest land, dividing this run from Burway Run; and again on the north-west by a line bearing east 35 degrees north extending about 4 miles to the point of commencement. The lengths and general directions of these boundary lines being given only with reasonable certainty, all the land within the said boundaries being of a most barren description and only available to depasture stock for a short period after the waterholes have been filled by heavy rains.

Name of Run—Bongegalong.

Estimated Area—5 miles (Square?)

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—550 Cattle.

Bounded south by the Martigay Creek 5 miles; north-east on a line from the same creek 5 miles adjoining Bobbera, Mr. Jackson's station, by line north-west on the same creek bounded by Mr. W. Lowe's station, Martigay, 4 miles. The run I put my claim for is 3 miles towards Bobbera, and 2 miles towards Martigay. Uncertain water.

No. 33.

Caley, Templer, and Rickards.
Name of Run—Bodanjiry.
Estimated Area—36,060 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—2,400 Sheep.

Bounded on the north by the Wodanga Creek; on the east by the Malah Creek; on the west by the Kangaroo ridges; on the south by the Mitchell's Creek. On the north it is occupied by R. V. Dulhunty; on the east, south, and west, by Caley, Templer, and Richards.

No. 34.

Caley, Templer, and Richards.
Name of Run—Wiligangeli (Melah.)
Estimated Area—24,870 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—1,400 Sheep.

Bounded on the north by a line drawn from a marked tree on the Kangaroo ridges to the Bald Hill; on the east by the Drill Creek; on the west by a belt of land commencing at a marked tree and running north to Mitchell's Creek; on the south by the line marking the boundary of the Settled District within 10 miles of the township of Wellington.

No. 35.

Cameron Alexander.
Name of Run—Hoblingrah (Manguil.)
Estimated Area—1,600 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—300 Cattle,
1,000 Sheep.

Situated on the Merri Going Going Creek, 8 miles east of the Castlereagh River, bounded on the north by the road leading from Biamble to Balara, and on the south by the road leading from Mandoran to Cobra; on the south-west corner by the Castlereagh River for about half a mile; and on the east by a dividing range, the waters on the east side of which fall into the Macquarie River, and on the west into the Castlereagh River; supposed length of each side line 5 miles, and adjoining the lands occupied by Mr. James Walker, and Mr. E. Hassall.

No. 36.

Cheeseborough Job Webster.
Name of Run—Coonamoona.
Estimated Area—24,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Plains and Myall scrub adjoining Mr. Bettington's sheep station on the south, and terminating 1 mile north of the waterhole called Coonamoona, includes a chain of waterholes of about 4 miles running southerly from Coonamoona being about 7 miles south-west from Walker's station called Coonambill, on the lower part of the Castlereagh River.

No. 37.

Dulhunty Robert Vernon.
Name of Run—Mullingundy.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—800 Cattle.

Bounded on the east by a waterhole called Bugginbedar; on the west by a waterhole near the boundary of Mr. William Lawson's run; on the north by a station of Mr. Lowe's, called Bundomar; on the south by a dry lagoon called the Cuddal.

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No. 38.

Dulhunty Robert Vernon.
Name of Run—Dubbo.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—3,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by a dry creek running into the M'Quarie River, near Butler's Fall; on the west by a line running north marked by the Commissioner; on the north by an Ironbark range; on the south by the Macquarie River.

No. 39.

Dulhunty Robert Vernon.
Name of Run—Barbigel.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—800 Cattle.

Bounded on the west by a waterhole called Brewer; on the east by Mitchells Creek; on the north by Tom Jones' Creek; and on the south by an Ironbark range.

No. 40.

Dulhunty Robert Vernon.
Name of Run—Spicer's Creek.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—2,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the west by a place called the Rocks; on the east by the boundary line of the Settled Districts of the Colony; on the south by Spicer's creek; and on the north by the Talbragan river.

No. 41.

Dawson R. B., now Charles Bury.
Name of Run—Caleriwi.
Estimated Area—30,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—400 Cattle.

Situated on the Wambolong Creek; bounded north by the Warrabangle ranges, and Mr. C. Roberts run; and also by the Caleriwi ranges extending towards Parmidman; west by Parmidman and M'Laren's run; south by Welsh and Fisher's run; east by Warrabangle ranges, and Mr. Roberts run; (has no permanent water excepting that which has been artificially obtained.)

N.B.—This Run has been transferred, with the sanction of the Government, to Mr. Charles Bury, in whose name the Lease will accordingly be prepared.

No. 42.

Dawson R. B., now Charles Bury.
Name of Run—Wolla Wolla.
Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—2,000 Sheep.

Situated on the Wolla Wolla watercourse at the head of the Warrener Creek; bounded east by the Tenandra Run; north by Mr. Bettington's Ulomogo run; west by a north and south line across the plain to include the quantity; east by Uhndry plains occupied by Mr. James Walker, (has no permanent water.)

N. B.—This run has been transferred, with the sanction of the Government, to Mr. Charles Bury, in whose name the Lease will accordingly be prepared.

No. 43.

Dawson R. B., now Charles Bury.
Name of Run—Tenandra, (including Parmidman.)
Estimated Area—32,000 Acres.
Estimated Grazing Capabilities—4,000 Sheep.

Includes the watercourses of Tenandra and Parmidman; bounded north by the Goriannawa plains,

and the runs of Messrs. Walker and Bettington; west by the plains of Ulomogo and Wolla Wolla; south by Mr. Andrew Brown's run, and Mr. James M'Laren's run; east by Caleriwi plains and ranges; (has no permanent water unless that which has been obtained artificially.)

N. B.—This run has been transferred, with the sanction of the Government, to Mr. Charles Bury, in whose name the Lease will accordingly be prepared.

No. 44.

Egan Anne.

Name of Run—Bebrue (Biabindo ?)

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—600 Cattle.

Bounded on the west by the River McQuarie; on the south by Mary Perry's, Merebone; on the north by Robert Martin's, Pebedebedy; on the east by Thomas Spicer, Gragery.

No. 45.

Edrop James.

Name of Run—Bulgoyar.

Estimated Area—12,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—500 Cattle, or 4,000 Sheep.

Bounded on the east by a chain of Ponds running into Wetalaba Creek, so as to include 3 waterholes known as Bulgogar, Bulgar, and Bungle; on the north by Wetalaba creek; on the west by the centre of a main range; and on the south by Sim's station.

No. 46.

Fitzsimmons Charles.

Name of Run—Tharunbone.

Estimated Area—32,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—400 Cattle.

Tharunbone situated on the borders of Tharunbone plains; bounded on the east by the Long Water Hole, on the Diringeri Creek; on the west by Bobalwarrawarra; on the north by a line of trees, marked C. F.; on the south by the Weetalaba Creek.

No. 47.

Gibson George.

Name of Run—Wullamgambone.

Estimated Area—6,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—700 Cattle.

Bounded on the west by the Macquarie River; bounded on the south-west line by John Jude's station; and the north-east by unoccupied land; not watered.

No. 48.

Giles Thomas.

Name of Run—Kabbin.

Estimated Area—16,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—600 Cattle.

North, south, and east by Mr. Edwin and Mr. George Rouse's stations; and on the west by Mr. James Walker's station.

No. 49.

Gardiner Andrew.

Name of Run—Nerrybone.

Estimated Area—5 Square Miles.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—2,500 Sheep.

Open flat country; and bounded on the west by the Macquarie River; on the south by the station of Mr. Hassal, called Narrow Bungaree; on the N. by Mrs. Perry's station, (Marebone.)

No. 50.

Hale James.

Name of Run—Tarawinda.

Estimated Area—20,000 Acres.

Estimated Grazing Capabilities—640 Cattle, or 4,000 Sheep.

Commencing at the round waterhole, at the junction of the Tarawinda with the Yuilermambre Creek, from thence by a line north dividing it from Mr. Cox's run to the Spring Sheep Station, taking in the spring, being about 10 miles; bounded on the north by the main range dividing it from Purcell's run; and on the east and west by scrub and ridges.
