**ROADS AND PUBLIC WORKS
BEYOND THE SETTLED DISTRICTS.**

THE sum of one thousand five hundred pounds having been provided by the Legislative Council "for Roads and Public Works beyond the Settled Districts," of the Sydney or Middle District of the Colony, during the year 1849, His Excellency the Governor directs it to be notified, that applications for the repair, &c., of such Roads and Works, so far as provided for by the above amount, should on or before the 1st of February next, be submitted for the consideration of the Government, through the Magistrates of the District, willing to superintend the execution of the work, with the assistance of other gentlemen in the neighbourhood.

A similar sum having also been appropriated for the Roads and Public Works beyond the Settled Districts of Port Phillip, applications for aid for these purposes, in that district, should in like manner, be made to His Honor the Superintendent at Melbourne.

NOTICE.

The system of recording all Transfers of Goods in Bond, as introduced in the year 1846, having been found to work extremely ill, the Honorable the Board of Customs have authorized its being altered, with the sanction of His Excellency the Governor; and notice is therefore hereby given, that in future no transfer of such goods will be recorded in the Transfer Book, except in cases where the goods sold are the property of the occupier of a Bonding Warehouse, as provided for in the 9th section of the Imperial Act of Parliament, 8 and 9 Victoria, chap. 91; and that no goods will in future be delivered from the warehouse, except upon the order of the person whose name is endorsed on the back of the bonding certificate, which will render it necessary that every time a sale of goods in bond takes place, the seller shall endorse on the back of the bonding certificate that the goods are sold to the person to whom the certificate is transferred.

In all cases the purchaser of goods under bond is authorized, by the 66th section of the 9th Victoria, No. 15, to give security by bond, that no part of such goods shall be taken out of the warehouse until duty entered for home consumption or exportation, thereby shewing that he is the owner of those goods, a course however, which has never been adopted in this colony, even when the transfer system was not in force.

WHEREAS by an Act intituled "An Act to alter and amend the Laws relating to the Savings' Banks of New South Wales and Port Phillip, respectively" it is enacted, that after the passing of the said Act, no deposit shall be received in the Savings' Banks under any order of the Supreme Court of the said Colony, or of the District of Port Phillip; or of any Judge thereof.

payments to or transactions with the said Savings' Bank, shall be made, done, and presented, in like manner in reference to the said Bank of Australia, or Union Bank of Australasia, or one of them, as if the said last mentioned Banks, or one of them had been respectively named in the said Rule or Rules.

**CROWN LANDS BEYOND THE
SETTLED DISTRICTS.**

**CAUTION AGAINST UNAUTHORISED
OCCUPATION.**

THE recent Proclamation of three new Commissioners' Districts, namely, the Burnett, the Maranoa, and Wide Bay, having rendered a large extent of country available for occupation on the terms prescribed in Her Majesty's Order in Council of 9th March, 1847, and the local regulations founded thereon,—His Excellency the Governor deems the present a fitting opportunity for cautioning all persons who may take unauthorised possession of Ruas of Crown Land, that although the Government may not find it practicable or expedient to take immediate measures for the removal of persons who may form Stations beyond the limits assigned to existing Commissioners' Districts, and consequently beyond the range of authorised occupation, the holding of the Lands upon which such Stations may be formed will not be regarded as in any degree permissive; or as conferring on the occupants the slightest preferential claim to Leases of the Lands whenever they may be placed under the superintendence of a Commissioner. On the contrary, any improvements effected by such occupants, will be entirely at their own risk, and they will be liable at any moment to be summarily removed under the provisions of the Act of Parliament, 9 and 10 Victoria, cap. 104.

2. His Excellency the Governor is prohibited by Law from disposing of Lands in the unsettled and intermediate Districts, in any other manner than by public Tender. Whenever therefore a new Commissioner's District may be formed, the Lands therein comprised will be let to the persons making the highest Tender for them without any reference to the persons previously in occupation of them, or to the improvements effected by them.

3. It is also to be distinctly understood that any persons found in unauthorised occupation of Crown Lands, within any District to which a Commissioner has been appointed, will be immediately proceeded against under the provisions of the Act of Parliament above referred to.
