PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR CHARLES AUGUSTUS FITZ ROY, Knight Companion of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Territory of New South Wales and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, passed in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for the better Government of Her Majesty's Australian "Colonies," it is amongst other things enacted, that the said Act shall be proclaimed in New South Wales, Van Diemen's Land, South Australia, and Western Australia, by the respective Governors thereof within six weeks after a copy of such Act shall have been received by such Governors respectively, and save as therein expressly provided, shall take effect within such Colonies respectively from the day of such proclamation thereof; and whereas I did on the eleventh day of January instant duly receive from the Right Honorable Earl Grey, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, a copy of the said Act: Now, therefore, I, Sir Charles Augustus Fitz Roy, as such Governor aforesaid, in pursuance of the directions in the said recited Act contained, do hereby proclaim the said Act, and that the same is in the words and figures hereunder written.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at Government House, Sydney, this thirteenth day of January, in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, and in the fourteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
