FIFTY POUNDS REWARD.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Government that on the night of the 15th instant, the Mail Cart conveying the mails from Melbourne to Geelong, was stopped upon the high road by two armed men, by whom the Mail Bags were rifled, and the greater part of their contents carried away.

I hereby give notice, in the name of his Excellency the Governor, that a Reward of Fifty Pounds will be paid to any person or persons who shall (by information or otherwise) apprehend or cause to be apprehended and lodged in safe custody the parties guilty of the above Robbery.
