By His Excellency Charles Joseph La Trobe, Esquire, Lieutenant Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council.

An Act to alter and increase the Sum appropriated to the payment of the Salary of the Governor of the Colony of Victoria. [6th January, 1853.]

HEREAS by an Act of the Imperial Parliament of Great Britain Preamble. and Ireland passed in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria intituled "An Act for the better "Government of Her Majesty's Australian Colonies" it was amongst other things enacted that there should be payable to Her Majesty every year out of the Revenue Funds arising from Taxes Duties Rates and Imposts levied within the Colony of Victoria after the establishment thereof the several sums mentioned in the Schedule (B) to the said Act such payments to be made for defraying the expenses of the services and purposes mentioned in the said Schedule and the said several sums to be issued by the Treasurer of the said Colony in discharge of such Warrants as should be from time to time directed to him under the hand and Seal of the Governor thereof And by the said Act it was also enacted that it should be lawful for the Governor and Legislative Council of the said Colony to alter all or any of the sums mentioned in the said Schedule and the appropriation of such sums to the services and purposes therein mentioned And whereas the increased wealth population and importance of the said Colony have rendered it expedient to alter and increase the amount of the sum mentioned in the first part of the said Schedule and thereby appropriated to the payment of the salary of the Governor of the said Colony Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor of the said Colony by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof that the said sum of Two thousand pounds mentioned in the first part of the said Schedule (B) to the said refet the Act and thereby appropriated to the payment of the salary of the Governor of the said Colony shall be altered and increased to and shall be the sum of Five thousand pounds and that the said sum of Five thousand pounds shall be payable to Her Majesty out of the Revenue Funds arising from Taxes Duties Rates and Imposts levied within the said Colony in lieu and instead of the said sum of Two thousand pounds and shall be appropriated to the payment of such salary instead of such sum of Two thousand pounds.

II. That this Act shall be deemed to have been in operation and Commencement of shall take effect from the first day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-two.
