PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency CHARLES JOSEPH LA TROBE, Esquire, Lieutenant Governor in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation published in the *Victoria Government Gazette*, and bearing date the 3rd day of January, A.D. 1853, it was, amongst other things appointed, that a Court of General Sessions should be holden for Buninyong, having jurisdiction in and for the district in the said Proclamation more particularly defined, and it was further appointed that the said Court should be holden at Buninyong aforesaid: And whereas it is expedient to alter the place of such holding, Now therefore I, the Lieutenant Governor of the said Colony, by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf, do hereby appoint that the Court of General Sessions for the said district shall be holden at Ballaarat in the said district, in the place and stead of Buninyong aforesaid, until further orders.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the said Colony, at Melbourne, in the said Colony, this 23rd day of November, One thousand eight hundred and fifty-three.
