## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency SIR CHARLES HOTHAM, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c .. &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Lieutenant Governor and Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria, passed in the eighteenth year of Her present Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act" to further alter 'The Victoria Electoral Act of "1851,' and to increase the number of Members " of the Legislative Council of Victoria," it was amongst other things enacted that there should be created and erected five new Electoral

Districts, to be called respectively the Electoral Districts of Castlemaine, Sandhurst, Ballacrat, Avoca, and the Ovens, and that the places for taking the poll at Elections in respect of the said newly created Electoral Districts should be those set forth in connection with each District in the schedule to the said Act annexed marked C, provided that such other places should be Polling Places for the said Electoral Districts respectively as should be appointed for that purpose by the Governor, by any Proclamation to be issued by him in that behalf and published in the Government Gazette: And whereas it has been deemed expedient to appoint additional Polling Places for the Electoral Districts of Castlemaine, Sandhurst, Avoca, and the Ovens: Now therefore I, the Governor of the said Colony, do by this my Proclamation, in pursuance of the power and authority so vested in me as aforesaid, declare and appoint that the undermentioned places shall be Polling Places for the several Electoral Districts specified in connection therewith respectively, in addition to the Polling Places appointed by the said Act, that is to say :-For the Electoral District of Castlemaine.-

Fryer's Creek.

For the Electoral District of Sandhurst .-Sailor's Gully, Lockwood, Rushworth.

For the Electoral District of Avoca.—Mary-borough, Adelaide Lead, Daisy Hill, Alma, Moliagul.

For the Electoral District of the Ovens .- The Woolshed.
