FURTHER PROROGATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Charles Hotham, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS the Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria has been and now stands prorogued to Tuesday, the sixth day of November next, and it is deemed expedient further to prorogue the said Council: Now therefore I, the Governor of the said Colony, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby further prorogue the said Legislative Council to Friday, the twenty-third day of the said month of November. And I do hereby further announce and proclaim that the said Legislative Council shall assemble for the despatch of business on the said twenty-third day of November, at Twelve o'clock at noon, in the Council Chamber, situate in Bourke-street, in the City of Melbourne; and the Members of the said Legislative Council are hereby required to give their attendance at the said time and place accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this thirtieth day of October, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-five, and in the nineteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
