WHEREAS by a Proclamation, bearing date the 28th day of December, A.D. 1854, the times and places for holding the several Courts of General Sessions then existing in the said Colony were declared and appointed; and whereas by another Proclamation, bearing date the 29th day of August, A.D. 1855, a Court of General Sessions for Warnnambool was established; and whereas by another Proclamation, bearing date the 11th day of September, A.D. 1855, a Court of General Sessions for Gipps Land was also established; and whereas by another Proclamation, bearing date the 11th day of September, A.D. 1855, a Court of General Sessions for Gipps Land was also established; and whereas it is expedient to appoint other times for holding the said first mentioned Courts; and also to appoint times for holding the two last-mentioned Courts: Now therefore, I, the Governor of the said Colony, by virtue of the powers vested in me in this behalf, do hereby appoint that the several Courts of General Sessions hereinafter mentioned, shall during the year 1856, and all subsequent years, until otherwise ordered, be holden respectively at the several places and times following, that is to say:—
