PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency SIR CHARLES HOTHAM, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Captain General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c.,

WHEREAS HER MAJESTY has been grated ciously pleased, by Commission, under the Great Scal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, bearing date at Westminster the second day of February, One thousand eight hundred and fifty-five, to constitute and appoint me, Sir Charles Hotham, Knight Commander of the most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, to be the Captain General and Governor-in-Chief in and over the Colony called Victoria: Now I, the Captain General and Governor-in-Chief aforesaid, do hereby proclaim and declare that I have this day taken the prescribed Oaths before His Honor Sir William A'Beckett, Knight, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the said Colony, and that I have assumed the said office of Captain General and Governor-in-Chief.

And I do hereby further proclaim and declare that HER MAJESTY has been pleased to nominate and appoint the undermentioned persons to be Members of the Executive Council of the said Colony, that is to say:—

THE SENIOR MILITARY OFFICER in Command of the Troops in Our said Colony.

THE COLONIAL SECRETARY for the time being of Our said Colony.

THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, or the Principal Law Officer of Our Crown of the said Colony for the time being.

THE COLONIAL TREASURER, or Treasurer of Our said Colony for the time being.

THE COLLECTOR OF CUSTOMS, or the Principal Officer of Customs of Our said Colony for the time being.

THE AUDITOR GENERAL, or Auditor General of Accounts of Our said Colony for the time being.

Chief Justice of the said Colony, and that I have assumed the office of Vice-Admiral, Commissary, and Deputy, accordingly.
