WHEREAS by an Act of the Lieutenant Governor and Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria, passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, "An Act to provide for the Management of Towns and other places in Victoria," it is amongst other things enacted, that certain provisions of the said Act relating to the good order of towns and other populous places, being sections V., VI., VII., VIII., IX. and X. in the said Act, should extend to and be in force in such cities, towns, districts, and places as the Lieutenant Governor might, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, declare to come under the operation of the same, respectively, or any of them, and that it shall be lawful for the Lieutenant Governor to define the limits of such places: Now I, the Governor of the said Colony, do, by this my Proclamation, in pursuance of the provisions of the said Act, declare and appoint that the sections of the said Act being numbered V., VI., VII., VIII., IX. and X., shall extend to and be in force within the Town of Warrnambool, in the said Colony: And I do define the limits of the said town to be the boundaries hereinafter set forth, that is to say:—Commencing on the River Hopkins at the south-west corner of allotment one of section one, in the parish of Wangoom, and bounded on the east by a line bearing north eighty chains; on the north by a line bearing west to the Merri River; thence by that river to its mouth; thence by the shores of Warrnambool Bay to the mouth of the Hopkins River; and by that river upwards to the commencing point, viz., the south-west corner of allotment one of section one, parish of Wangoom.
