HIS Excellency the Governor, in pursuance of the authority vested in him by an Act of the Governor and Legislative Council of New South Wales, 13 Victoria, No. 29, hereby declares that the Township of Lexton, the boundaries of which are specified below, shall come within the operation of the 3rd clause of the said Act, so as to constitute it a place at which any fermented or spirituous liquor, or any mixed liquor, part of which is fermented or spirituous, may be sold in quantities of not less than two gallons at one time.
