POLLING PLACES FOR ELECTORAL DISTRICTS OF NORTH GRANT AND NORTH GRENVILLE.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Major-General MACARTHUR, the Senior Military Officer in Command of Her Majesty's Land Forces in the Colony of Victoria, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of an Act of the Governor and Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria, passed in the nineteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act to provide for the Election of Members to serve in the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Victoria respectively:" I, Major-General MACARTHUR, the Senior Military Officer and Officer administering the Government of the said Colony, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation abolish the several polling places (already appointed) for the several divisions mentioned in the first column of the Schedules hereunto annexed; and, with the advice aforesaid, I do hereby appoint that the several places mentioned in the last column of the Schedules hereunto annexed shall be respectively polling places for the purpose of taking the poll at any contested election for the districts within the limits whereof such places are respectively situate, and that all votes in respect of qualifications within the boundaries and limits mentioned or referred to in the second column of the same Schedules shall be taken at any election for such districts respectively at the polling place or polling places set opposite to the names of the respective divisions of such districts in the said last column, that is to say:—
