ELECTION PETITION.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Act of Council 19 Victoria No. 12, I hereby notify that there has been addressed and presented this day to me, as Speaker of the Legislative Assembly of Victoria, a Petition, subscribed by Hector Norman Simson, an elector on the roll of the Electoral District of Talbot, complaining of the election and return of David Blair to serve as a Member of the Legislative Assembly for the said electoral district, and praying that the election and return of the said David Blair for such district may be declared to be void on the grounds of want of qualification, insolvency, and the being a Minister of the Independent Church, and that such further proceedings may be taken thereon as the said Assembly shall think fit.
