#### MUNICIPALITY OF PRAHRAN.

Bye-Law 36.—A Bye-law for the Appropriation of the Sum of £5000 granied out of the Public Revenue for the Year 1856 to the Municipal District of Prahran.

WHEREAS by the Act of Council 18 Victoria No. 15, intituled, "An Act of Council 18 Victoria No. 15, intituled, "An Act for the Establishment of Municipal "Institutions in Victoria," it is amongst other things enacted, "That every work proposed to be executed by any Municipal Council by funds raised by aid from the Government, whether by endowment or otherwise, shall be the subject of a distinct and separate bye-law;" and whereas by the Act of Council 19 Victoria No. 17, being the Act for the appropriation of the revenue for 1856, the sum of £5000 is granted to the Municipal Council of Prahran, subject to the conditions of the first recited Act. Be it therefore enacted by the Council of the Municipal District of Prahran, that the said sum of £5000 shall be expended in forming, draining and channelling Chapel-road, Commercial-road and High-street, according to plans and specifications submitted to the Executive Council, the said plans having been assented to by His Excellency the Officer administering the Government, except the sum of £150 appropriated for the purchase of land for the purpose of erecting a Court House and Lockup thereon.

The foregoing Bye-law, No. 36, made by the Municipal Council of Prahran, has been assented to by His Excellency the Officer administering the Government, with the advice of the Executive Council.
