FURTHER PROROGATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Major-General MACARTHUR, the Senior Military Officer in Command of Her Majesty's Land Forces in the Colony of Victoria, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS the Legislative Council of the Colony of Victoria has been and now stands prorogued to Tuesday, the nineteenth day of the current month of August, and it is deemed expedient further to prorogue the said Council: Now therefore I, Major-General MACARTHUR, the Senior Military Officer and Officer administering the Government of the said Colony, with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the power and authority in me vested, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Legislative Council to Tuesday, the sixteenth day of September now next ensuing.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this eighteenth day of August, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and in the twentieth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
