IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE COLONY OF VICTORIA.

REGULA GENERALIS.

THAT on and after the 5th October, 1857, the Court held before a single Judge sitting in Equity will take business in the following order, so far as practicable : The hearing of Causes and Demurrers (as set down in the List), on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays, in two consecutive weeks. The taking Evidence on the like days in the third week, and so on in rotation, except during the days set apart for hearing Appeals in Equity and during the Recess. And the hearing of Motions of Course, and such other pressing Motions as the Master may enter in the list, on Thursday in every week, after the disposal of the business before the Court in its Insolvency Jurisdiction. That Appeals in Equity be heard before the full Court between the 1st and 15th days of May, the 17th and 30th days of September, and the 14th and 24th days of December in each year.
