COUNTY COURTS.

ORDER OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

*At the Government House, Melbourne, the 14th day of December, 1857.*

**W**HEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, "*An Act for the more easy recovery of certain Debts and Demands,*" it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, to direct that County Courts shall be holden for the recovery of debts and demands under the said Act, and from time to time, with the advice aforesaid, to direct in what towns and places a County Court shall be holden : Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present order direct, That on and after the first day of January now next ensuing, County Courts shall be holden for the recovery of debts and demands, under the said Act, in the towns and places following, that is to say :—Alberton, Ararat, Ballaarat, Beechworth, Belfast, Carisbrook, Castlemaine, Dunolly, Geelong, Hamilton, Kilmore, Kyneton, Melbourne, Portland, Sandhurst, and Warrnambool.

And the Honorable Archibald Michie, Her Majesty's Attorney General for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
