QUARANTINE OF THE "BLACK SWAN."

THE occurrence of a disease said to have been Small-pox, on board of the vessel *Black Swan*, during the passage from London, having been reported to the Government, His Excellency the Governor, has ordered the said vessel, and the crew and passengers on board thereof, to be placed in quarantine, at the Quarantine Station at Point Nepean until released; and all persons are hereby required to take notice accordingly.

The boundaries of the Quarantine Station at Point Nepean are specified in a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of November, 1852.
