WHEREAS by an Act passed in the twenty-first year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled, "An Act to enable the Postmaster General to issue Money Orders in the colony of Victoria," it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time order and direct what shall be deemed "Separate Post Towns or places," within the meaning of the 3rd section of the Act of the Governor and Legislative Council of Victoria, passed in the eighteenth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, intituled, "An Act to amend an Act intituled, 'An Act 'to amend the Law relating to the Post Office:—' Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order direct that the municipalities of Richmond, Emerald Hill, Prahran, St. Kilda, and East Collingwood, shall be deemed as within the limits of the city in which the General Post Office is situated, for the purposes of the above recited Act; and that all letters delivered through the several Post Offices of Melbourne, Richmond, Emerald Hill, Prahran, St. Kilda, and East Collingwood, within the boundaries of the municipalities aforesaid, shall be subject to the town rate of postage, viz. :—Two pence per single rate of half an ounce, and so on in proportion.

And the Honorable George Samuel Evans, LL.D., Her Majesty's Postmaster General for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

BYE-LAW No. 17.—FOR APPROPRIATING THE SECOND MOIETY OF £3750 OF THE GOVERNMENT GRANT TO THIS MUNICIPALITY FOR THE MUNICIPAL YEAR 1856-7.

WHEREAS a distinct bye-law is required under the 18th Victoria No. 15, for the appropriation of any funds received from the public revenue: Be it and it is hereby enacted by the municipal council of Beechworth that the second moiety of £3750 of the Legislative Grant to this municipality for 1856-7, be expended on the following works, *viz.*—

1. The permanent formation of Camp street from High street to Finch street, and its temporary formation thence to Last street.

2. The improvement of the footpaths in Ford street.

3. The primary clearing of Last street, William street, and the Market Reserve.

4. The clearing and partly forming the suburban road from the Red Hill Mining Company's corner to the public Recreation Reserve.

5. The sinking a public well, and the erection of a public pump in High street.

6. The formation of New Ford street from Short street to the bridge.

The foregoing Bye-law, No. 17, made by the municipal council of Beechworth, has been assented to by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council.

MUNICIPALITY OF CASTLEMAINE.

BYE-LAW No. 34.—FOR AN ASSESSMENT OF HOUSE AND LAND PROPERTY WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT FOR THE YEAR 1858.

WHEREAS by the Act of Council 18 Victoria No. 15, intitled, "An Act for the Establishment of Municipal Institutions in Victoria," the council of any municipal district is empowered to make an annual assessment of all property in houses and lands within the limits of such municipal district according to its fair average annual value: Be it therefore enacted that the assessment on the annual value of property within the municipality of Castlemaine, estimated at Seventy-nine thousand four hundred and seventy-one pounds, as approved of by the justices of peace in petty sessions assembled, shall be the value on which a rate shall be levied, and shall be legal and in force for the municipal year commencing 28th January, 1858, and ending 27th January, 1859.

The foregoing Bye-law, No. 34, made by the municipal council of Castlemaine, has been assented to by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council.
