**PROPOSED ROAD DISTRICT.**

PARISHES OF FRANKLIN, YANDOIT, ETC., COUNTY OF TALBOT.  
IT is hereby notified that a petition has been presented to the Governor, signed by sixty-one inhabitants of the parishes of Franklin, Yandoit, and other portions of the Hepburn or Mount Franklin district, in the county of Talbot, setting forth to the following effect, viz.:-

That their locality is one of great and increasing importance from its mining and agricultural capabilities, and that it includes upwards of 5000 acres of alienated and cultivated land, and portions of the Mount Franklin and Yandoit gold fields.

That the want of suitable roads to connect the district with the principal lines of traffic has subjected the petitioners to great damage and loss, even the main roads being at times scarcely passable.

That notwithstanding the large amount contributed by the district to the public revenue through land sold, mining receipts, and other sources of public income, none of it has at any time been expended in forming roads and bridges therein.

That the petitioners are desirous of immediately forming a road via Daylesford, Spring Creek, and the Jim Crow or Mount Franklin Creek to Franklinsford, there to join the Government road from Castlemaine to Creswick and Ballarat, and thereby avoiding the circuitous and difficult road through the ranges.

And the petitioners pray as follows:-

"Your petitioners therefore humbly pray that your Excellency will be pleased to proclaim this a Road Board district in terms of the Act of Council in that case made and provided, the extent and boundaries of such district being specified in the schedule annexed to this petition."

(The Schedule above referred to.)

PROPOSED BOUNDARIES OF THE ROAD BOARD DISTRICT OF HEPBURN, FRANKLIN, AND YANDOIT:—Beginning at the north-west angle of allotment 53, section 2, parish of Wombat, northern boundary of the municipal district of Daylesford; thence north 120 chains; thence west 24 chains; thence north 340 chains; thence west 104 chains; thence north 19 chains 50 links; thence west 67 chains 32 links; thence in a line north to the north-east angle of section 3, parish of Yandoit, 224 chains; thence west 272 chains, south 224 chains, east 136 chains, south 80 chains, east 88 chains; thence along the Jim Crow Creek to a point opposite allotment 2, section 5, parish of Franklin, 120 chains; thence in a line south 288 chains, and thence in a line east parallel with the boundary line of the municipality of Daylesford 240 chains to the commencing point aforesaid.

**COUNTER-PETITION UNDER THE MUNICIPAL ACT.**  
CARLTON.

THE Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has directed the publication of the substance and prayer of the counter-petition hereinafter set forth, signed by four hundred and ninety-five freeholders, householders, and residents in the portion of the city of Melbourne designated Carlton, opposed to the separation thereof from the city, as prayed for in the petition published on the 22nd ultimo and at subsequent dates.

The counter-petitioners state that they are freeholders, householders, and residents within the boundaries set forth in the petition from Carlton, praying for separation from the city of Melbourne (*published in p. 2489 et seq. ante*).

That they are induced to oppose the granting of the prayer of such petition for the following reasons:—

1st. That they have purchased land in Carlton from the Crown within two years to an amount exceeding £100,000, under the impression that they thereby acquired a right to participate in the municipal privileges of the city within which their property is located; that owing to the recent settlement of the district the improvements effected therein are trifling in comparison with what are necessary for health and comfort; and that they believe that its unimproved state is attributable to the recent agitation by several of the outlying districts of the city for separation, which makes the city council delay the effecting of permanent improvements until the question as to separation is settled.

2nd. That the amount of rateable house property shows a rental of only £14,000, which at 5 per cent. (a rate which they consider suitable to their circumstances), yields £700 only, an amount which, even with the tax on unoccupied land and the grant-in-aid, they deem insufficient to meet the necessary expenses of a municipal staff and to make improvements such as they state they have a right to expect.

They desire also to draw attention to the fact that upwards of 120 residents in Carlton who signed the petition for separation have also signed this counter-petition, thereby showing that those persons either signed the separation petition without due consideration or were induced to do so through misrepresentation of facts.

And the counter-petitioners pray as follows:—

"Your petitioners therefore pray that your Excellency will be pleased not to accede to the prayer of the said petition referred to in the first paragraph."
