  3.—9:30 a.m. cirri, and b lower stratum of white and grey clouds moving quickly from the 8.; squall and rain at 9 a.m. 5:30 p.m. small soft detached cumuli; fine, 9:30 p.m. dark clouds.

  3.—9:30 a.m. small detached white clouds moving from the southward; fine, 3:30 p.m. very slight haze on the extreme E. horizon; fine, 9:30 p.m. fine and clear; whooling star at 9:40 p.m.

  4.—9:30 a.m. cloudless; warm and fine, 3:30 p.m. one or two small cumuli, and a bank of light brown vapour in the east; fine and warm. 9:30 p.m. fine and clear.
