DIVISIONS OF THE ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF NORTH GIPPS LAND AND OF THE
EASTERN PROVINCE, ALTERED.

At the Government House, Melbourne, the 9th day of May, 1859.

WHEREAS by two several Orders of the Governor in Council, bearing date the twenty-first day of March now last past, the electoral districts and provinces were divided, and the limits and boundaries of the divisions thereof were defined as therein mentioned: And whereas it is expedient to alter the divisions of the electoral district of North Gipps Land, and the Sale, Snowy Creek, and Mitchell divisions of the Eastern Province: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order annul the said divisions of the electoral district of North Gipps Land and of the Eastern Province respectively, and doth hereby divide the said district and the portion of the said province comprised within the divisions hereinbefore mentioned into the divisions named in the third column of the schedule hereunto annexed, and doth appoint that the limits and boundaries of such divisions shall be the limits and boundaries mentioned in the fourth column of the same schedule opposite to the names of such divisions respectively, that is to say:—

Electoral Province.	Electoral District.	Divisions.	Description of Limits and Boundaries.
Eastern ...	North Gipps Land	Western ...	Bounded on the south-east by the sea; on the south, west, and north by the southern, western, and northern boundaries of the electoral district; on the east by the Rivers MacAlister, Thomson, and La Trobe; and again on the north by the southern shores of Lake Wellington to the sea coast.
		Middle ...	Bounded on the west and south by the Rivers MacAlister, Thomson, and La Trobe; on the east by Lake Wellington; on the north-east and east by the River Avon; and on the north by the Great Dividing Range.
		Eastern ...	Bounded on the south-east and south by the sea coast and the shores of Lake Wellington; on the south-west and west by the River Avon; and thence by the Great Dividing Range and the line forming part of the north-eastern boundary of the province to the sea coast.

And the Honorable John O'Shanassy, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
