PERIODS FOR THE FIRST SUPPLEMENTARY REGISTRATION.

NOTICE is hereby given that the dates fixed by the Registration Act, 22 Victoria No. 81, for the performance of the under-mentioned Acts in reference to the preparation and completion of the First Supplementary Electoral Lists, are postponed as follows, viz.:

Acts, matters, or things to be done.	Dates as extended.
The time within which the Registrars shall receive claims so as to ensure registration at the first supplementary revision	From 10th June to 1st July.
Time for preparing lists	Between 1st July and 3rd July.
Time for transmission of lists to clerks of petty sessions	"Forthwith," after 3rd July.
Time at which clerks of petty sessions "shall cause copies of lists to be exhibited," and during which they shall keep copies of such lists in their respective offices "for inspection"	As soon as possible after receipt of lists from Registrars, and until termination of sitting of revision court.
Time for receiving objections	From 3rd July till 19th July.
Sitting of Revision Court	From 20th July till 27th July.
Time at which First Supplementary Rolls shall be completed	1st August.

Simple forms of claims, which are hereunder given, will be forthwith printed and circulated in order to facilitate the registration of persons whose names shall have been omitted from the Annual Rolls, which rolls will be completed on the 10th of June; and a form may be had, free of expense, by any one desiring to be registered, at the offices of the respective Registrars, Clerks of Petty Sessions, and at Police Stations and Post Offices throughout the country.

The several Registrars will receive, include in the List, and transmit to the Revision Court, all claims made in respect of any qualification. Care should be taken by the applicant to fill up the blank in the form of application with the full number of months during which he has actually resided, or possessed his qualification, if a property one, previous to the date of his claim.
