LEASE OF PROTECTORATE RESERVE ON THE GOULBURN.

TENDERS will be received at this office till Monday, the 28th day of January next, for the lease, to the end of the ensuing year, 1861, of the Old Protectorate Reserve on the Goulburn (area about 27 square miles).

A right-of-way ten chains wide along the northern boundary for stock to pass to water in dry seasons will be reserved,

together with the agricultural reserve, and any land measured for sale or which may be required for commonage. The license will be liable to the assessment on stock as provided in Act No. 79.

The reserve will be let subject to be resumed at any time after giving one month's notice to the occupant, the latter to be allowed a rebate of license fee for the unexpired residue of the term
