THE CIRCUIT COURTS OF VICTORIA DURING THE YEAR 1862.

*At the Government House, Melbourne, the sixteenth day of December, 1861.*

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the fifteenth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to make provision for the better administration of Justice in the Colony of Victoria*, it was amongst other things enacted, that it should be lawful for the Governor of the said colony, by any orders to be by him, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, from time to time made and proclaimed, to define the limits of districts within and the times at which circuit courts should be holden in the said colony, and the said limits and times to alter and vary as he should, with the advice aforesaid, deem necessary: And whereas it is expedient to fix the times at which the several circuit courts of Victoria shall be holden during the year 1862: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order proclaim and direct that the times at which the several circuit courts of Victoria shall be holden during the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, shall be as follow, that is to say:—

At ARAKAT, on—  
Wednesday the fifth day of February  
Friday the eleventh day of July

At BALLAARAT, on—  
Tuesday the eleventh day of February  
Friday the eleventh day of April  
Friday the eighteenth day of July  
Monday the thirteenth day of October

At BEECHWORTH, on—  
Thursday the tenth day of April  
Thursday the twenty-third day of October

At CASTLEMAINE, on—  
Friday the twenty-first day of February  
Thursday the first day of May  
Thursday the twenty-fourth day of July  
Thursday the ninth day of October

At GEELONG, on—  
Monday the seventeenth day of February  
Thursday the seventeenth day of April  
Thursday the twenty-fourth day of July  
Monday the twentieth day of October

At MARYBOROUGH, on—  
Friday the fourteenth day of February  
Wednesday the sixteenth day of July

At PORTLAND, on—  
Monday the fifth day of May  
Monday the twenty-ninth day of September

At SANDHURST, on—  
Friday the seventh day of February  
Thursday the twenty-fourth day of April  
Wednesday the ninth day of July  
Friday the third day of October

RULE UNDER THE PLEURO-PNEUMONIA IN CATTLE ACT.

THE Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Rule, under the Act No. 123, viz:—

The boundaries prescribed by the Rules of the 25th of November, 1861, within which Cattle are prohibited from crossing the River Murray into Victoria, are hereby extended from the junction of the Cudgewong Creek to five miles above the crossing-place at Towong or Gravel Plains.
