PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR HENRY BARKLY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the session of Parliament holden in the twenty-third and twenty-fourth years of Her present Majesty's reign, intitled, *An Act for regulating the Sale of Crown Lands and for other purposes*, it is amongst other things enacted, that the Governor in Council shall have full power from time to time by proclamation to define what shall be considered Towns within the meaning of the said Act: Now therefore I, Sir Henry Barkly, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation, with the advice of the Executive Council, declare and order that the areas hereinafter defined shall be considered Towns within the meaning of the said Act, that is to say:—

APSLEY, County unnamed, situate near the South Australian boundary.—Commencing at the north-east angle, bearing north 5 chains from the north-east angle of suburban allotment 1. Apsley; thence south 80 chains; thence west 160 chains; thence north 80 chains; and thence east 160 chains to the point of commencement.

AVENEL, Parish of Avenel.—Commencing at a point one chain south of south-west angle of suburban allotment 1, in parish of Avenel; bounded on the north by a line bearing east 113 chains 15 links; on the east by a line bearing south 113 chains 15 links; on the south by a line bearing west 113 chains 15 links; on the west by a line bearing north 113 chains 15 links to the commencing point.

AXEDALE, County unnamed, Parish of Axedale.—Commencing at the north-west angle, being a point bearing south 1 chain from the south-west angle of allotment 13 section 6; thence south 80 chains; thence east 54 chains 2 links to the Campaspe River; thence by that river north-easterly to a point bearing due east of the commencing point; thence west 79 chains 50 links to the commencing point.

BADDAGINNIE, County unnamed, Devil's River District.—Commencing at the north-east angle of the town reserve, being a point bearing north 8 chains 25 links from the intersection of the north side of the Melbourne and Sydney road with the east boundary of the township; bounded on the north by a line bearing west 80 chains; thence south 80 chains, crossing the Melbourne and Sydney road; thence east 80 chains; thence north 80 chains, again crossing the Melbourne and Sydney road, to the point of commencement.

BAIRNSDALE, County unnamed, Parish of Bairnsdale.—Commencing at the southern angle of portion 14, in the township of Bairnsdale; thence north 129 chains 60 links to the Macarthur River; thence south-easterly by the Macarthur River to the northern side of Main street; thence by the northern side of Main street S. 69° 25' west 30 chains 42 links, S. 65° 42' west

95 chains 39 links, S. 49° 10' west 50 chains to the point of commencement.

BALLAN, Counties of Bourke and Grant, Parish of Ballan.—Commencing at the south-west angle, being the north-east angle of allotment 2, section 3, parish of Ballan; thence east along the north boundaries of allotments 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 of section 3, 8⁰ chains; thence north along the west boundaries of allotments 11, 10, 8, 5, 3, and 1 of section 4, parish of Ballan, and a line 80 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence south 80 chains to the point of commencement.

BALLYSHANASSY, County of Bourke, Parish of Nunawading.—Commencing at a point on the Main Creek, being the north-west angle of portion 11, in the parish of Nunawading; thence on the north by the south side of a road bearing west 7 chains 20 links; thence S. 69° 30' W. 22 chains 80 links; thence S. 74° 30' west 21 chains 80 links; thence on the west by the east side of a road 1 chain wide, bearing south 15 chains 51 links; thence on the south by the north side of a road bearing east 38 chains 42 links to the Main Creek, and on the east by the Main Creek northerly to the commencing point.

BALMORAL, County of Dundas.—Commencing at the south-east angle of allotment 14, section 2; thence north 108 chains; thence east 49 chains to the Glenelg River; thence by that river southerly and easterly to a point bearing due north from the north-east angle of section 1; thence south 20 chains to said north-east angle; thence west 64 chains along the north boundary of section 1 to the commencing point.

BANNOCKBURN, County of Grant, Parish of Murgheboluc.—Commencing at the north-west angle of allotment 1, section 18, parish of Murgheboluc, bounded on the east by the west boundaries of allotments 1 of section 18, and allotments 31, 32, 33, 36, 37, 54, and 55 of section 21; thence west (crossing a road 1 chain wide) 79 chains; thence north 80 chains to the south side of the main line of road from Sheldford to Geelong S. 86° E. 51 chains 70 links; thence N. 80° 15' E. 25 chains 60 links more or less; thence N. 54° 30' east 2 chains 60 links to the point of commencement.

BARINGHUP, County unnamed, situate on the Loddon River.—Commencing at the north-east angle of the town reserve, being a point bearing north 1 chain from the north-west angle of allotment 1, section 1 B, parish of Baringhup; thence south 65 chains; thence west to the Loddon River; thence by that river northerly to a point due west of the commencing point; thence east 70 chains, more or less, to the commencing point.

BARNAWATTA, County unnamed, Murray District.—Commencing at the south-east angle of the town reserve, being a point bearing east 21 chains 94 links from the intersection of the main road from Barnawatta to Beechworth with the south boundary of the township; thence west 80 chains; thence north 80 chains, crossing the road from Wangaratta to Belvoir; thence east 80 chains, again crossing the road from Wangaratta to Belvoir; thence south 80 chains to the point of commencement.

BEAUFORT, County of Ripon, Parish unnamed.—Commencing at north-east angle of police paddock; thence west 190 chains;

thence south 80 chains; thence east 100 chains, thence north 80 chains to the point of commencement.

BELFAST, County of Villiers.—Commencing at the south-west corner of James Atkinson's purchased land A at Belfast Lough; thence by the western side of portion A, bearing N. 15° west 71 chains 40 links, to the south side of Belfast Lough; thence by the south side of Belfast Lough south-westerly and southerly to the south point of a reserve situate south of Campbell street, Belfast; thence by the western and northern shores of Port Fairy Bay northerly and north-easterly to the commencing point.

BENALLA, Parish of Benalla.—Commencing at the south-west angle of suburban allotment 9, section 1, in the parish of Benalla; thence on the north by a line bearing due east to the south-west angle of section 4, in same parish; thence on the east by a line bearing south to the south-west angle of allotment 1, section 8, in same parish; thence on the south by a tributary of the Broken River and the Broken River westerly to the northern boundary of allotment 1, section 9, in same parish, by that northern boundary and a line west to north-east angle of lot 4, section 12; thence on the east by a line due north to the Broken River, and again on the north by that river easterly to the commencing point.

BERWICK, County of Mornington, Parish of Berwick.—Commencing at a point on the Cardinia Creek, being the south-east angle of section 16, in the parish of Berwick; thence on the north by a line bearing west 134 chains; thence on the west by the east side of a road bearing south 40 chains to the north side of the main line of road to Gipps Land; thence east 15 chains; thence south 60° E. 93 chains; thence by a line east to the Cardinia Creek, and on the east by that creek northerly to the commencing point.

BET-BET, County of Talbot and County unnamed.—Commencing at the south-west angle of suburban allotment 17, parish of Bet-bet; thence west 40 chains; thence north by the east boundary of suburban allotment 1 and a line 80 chains; thence east 40 chains; thence south 80 chains to the point of commencement.

BEVERIDGE, County of Bourke, Parish of Merriang.—Commencing at the north-east angle of section 12, parish of Merriang; bounded on the west by the east boundaries of section 13, same parish, bearing north 80 chains; on the north by the north side of Minton street, bearing east 120 chains; on the east by section 15, parish of Merriang, bearing south 80 chains; and on the south by part of section 10 and section 11, parish of Merriang, bearing west 120 chains to the commencing point.

BRADFORD, County unnamed, situate off main line of road from Newbridge to Castlemaine.—Commencing at a point on the south side of the road from Newbridge to Castlemaine, where it is intersected by the east boundary of the town reserve; thence south 16 chains 68 links; thence S. 89° 34' west 87 chains; thence north 84 chains 23 links; thence east 87 chains, crossing the road from Newbridge to Castlemaine; thence south 66 chains 88 links to the point of commencement.

BRANXHOLME, County of Normanby.—Commencing at the south-east angle of the township reserve, being a point bearing east 1 chain from the south-east angle of suburban allotment 8, Branxholme; thence north 79 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence south 79 chains; thence last 80 chains, crossing the Arandoorong Creek to commencing point.

BRAYBROOK, County of Bourke, Parishes of Dounta Galla and Cut-paw-paw.—Commencing at the north-east angle of section 19, in the parish of Cut-paw-paw; bounded on the west by a line bearing south to the north-west angle of section 17, same parish; thence on the south by a line bearing east to the south-west angle of allotment 8, section 20, in the same parish; thence on the east by western boundary of same, and a line crossing the Salt Water River, bearing due north to south-west angle of lot 1 block 11 in the township of Braybrook; thence by the Salt Water River easterly to south-east angle of same; thence by a line bearing due north 29 chains 68 links; thence by a line bearing E. 15° north to point of commencement.

BRIDGEWATER, County unnamed, situate on the road from Inglewood to Sandhurst.—Commencing at a point on the Loddon River, bearing south-westerly about 55 chains 50 links in a straight line from the crossing of the road from Inglewood to Sandhurst over the Loddon River; thence east 137 chains 20 links; thence north 80 chains; thence west 72 chains 60 links to the Loddon River; thence by that river south-westerly to the point of commencement.

BROADMEADOWS, County of Bourke, Parish of Will-will-rook.—Commencing at the intersection of the west side of Hackett street, with the Moonee Moonee Ponds; thence by the west side of Hackett street south 23 chains 55 links; thence east by the south side of Forman street 33 chains to the Moonee Moonee Ponds; thence by the Moonee Moonee Ponds easterly to the intersection of the east side of Lyons street therewith; thence north by that side of Lyons street 34 chains to the north side of Kenny street; thence west by that side of Kenny street 80 chains; thence south 3 chains 80 links to the Moonee Moonee Ponds; thence by those ponds westerly to the point of commencement.

BRUTHEN, Parishes of Bruthen and Woodside.—Commencing at a point $\frac{1}{2}$ chains south, and $\frac{1}{2}$ east of the south eastern angle of Buntine's pre-emptive section, in the parish of Bruthen; thence

on the north by a line bearing east 80 chains; on the east by a line bearing south 80 chains; on the south by a line bearing west 80 chains; and on the west by a line bearing north 80 chains to the point of commencement.

BULLA, County of Bourke, Parish of Bulla Bulla.—Commencing at a point being the south-west angle of allotment A of section 20 in the parish of Bulla Bulla; thence on the north by a line bearing east 10 chains 37 links to the Deep Creek; thence by the said creek easterly to southern boundary line of allotment A of section 5, in same parish; thence by said line bearing due east 62 chains 80 links to south-east angle of said allotment; thence on the east by a line bearing due south 80 chains; thence on the south by a line bearing due west, crossing the Deep Creek to the south-east angle of allotment A, section 19, in same parish; thence on the west by a line bearing N. 27° W. 30 chains 10 links; thence north 43 chains 22 links; thence N. 47° W. 12 chains 68 links to south-western angle of allotment C, section 20, in the same parish; and thence by a line due east to the commencing point.

BUNDALONG, County unnamed, Murray District, at junction of Ovens and Murray Rivers.—Commencing at the south-west angle of the town reserve, being a point bearing west 1 chain 50 links from the south-east angle of suburban allotment 11 of section 4; thence north 95 chains, more or less, to an anna-branch of the Murray River; thence by that anna-branch south-easterly to the junction of the Ovens with the Murray River; thence by the Ovens River southerly to a point due east of the commencing point; thence west by a line 87 chains, more or less, to the point of commencement.

BUNCEP, County of Mornington.—Commencing at the south-west angle of the town reserve, said south-west angle bearing west 1 chain from the north-west angle of suburban allotment 5; bounded on the west by a line bearing north 80 chains; on the north by a line bearing east 80 chains, crossing the Buncep Creek; on the east by a line bearing south 80 chains; and on the south by a line and the north boundaries of suburban allotments 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, again crossing the Buncep Creek 80 chains west to the commencing point.

CAMPBELLTOWN, County of Talbot, Parish of Campbelltown.—Commencing at the north-east corner of the allotment 1 in the parish of Glengower; bounded on the west by a line bearing south to the north-west angle of portion 7 in the parish of Campbelltown; and bounded on the south by a line bearing east to Joyce's Creek; on the east by said creek bearing north-westerly to a point due east from the commencing point; and thence on the north by a line bearing west to the commencing point.

CAMPERDOWN, County of Hampden, Parish of Colongulac.—Commencing at the south-west angle of the town reserve bearing south 1 chain from the south-west angle of suburban allotment 20 section 16 Camperdown; thence east 80 chains; thence north 160 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence south 160 chains to the point of commencement.

CARAMUT, County of Villiers.—Commencing at a point on the north side of the town reserve, bearing north 1 chain from the north-west angle of town allotment 11, section 3, Caramut; thence east 45 chains 10 links; thence south 80 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence north 80 chains; thence east 34 chains 90 links to the point of commencement.

CARISBROOK, County of Talbot, Parish of Carisbrook.—Commencing at a point 1 chain east of the north-east angle of portion 17 in the parish of Carisbrook; thence by a line west crossing the Mount Greenock Creek, 160 chains; thence on the west by a line bearing north 80 chains to the south-west angle of portion 6, same parish; thence on the north by a line bearing due east 160 chains; thence on the east by a line, the Tullaroop Creek, and a line bearing south to the commencing point.

CARLSRUHE, County of Dalhousie, Parish of Carlsruhe.—Commencing at a point on the Campaspe River, being the south-west angle of portion 10 in the parish of Carlsruhe; thence east to south-west angle of portion 8 in same parish; thence south to north-west angle of portion 4 in same parish; thence west to the Campaspe River; thence by that river northerly to the point of commencement.

CARNHAM (on Bailie's Creek), Counties of Ripon and Grenville.—Commencing at the south-east corner of section 1; thence west 80 chains; thence north 80 chains; thence east 80 chains; and thence south 80 chains to the commencing point.

CARTERTON, Counties of Follet and Dundas.—Commencing on the left bank of the River Glenelg, 18 chains, more or less, north-west of Kirby's Bridge, thence east 60 chains 30 links to the south-east angle of allotment 6, section 12; thence south 80 chains; thence west 120 chains, crossing the Glenelg; thence north 109 chains 50 links, crossing the Glenelg to the left bank thereof; and thence by that bank to the commencing point.

CASTLE DONNINGTON (Swan Hill), County unnamed, Parish of Castle Donnington.—Commencing at a point on the west bank of the Murray River, being the south-east angle of section 1 in the parish of Castle Donnington; thence west 80 chains; thence south 80 chains; thence east 100 chains to the west bank of the Murrabit River; thence by that river and the Murray northerly to the point of commencement.

CAVENDISH, County of Dundas.—Commencing on the west boundary at a point bearing west 32 chains, more or less, from the south-west corner of the bridge over the River Wannon, at

Barker street; thence north 83 chains; thence east 80 chains; thence south 160 chains, crossing the River Wannan; thence west 80 chains; and thence north 77 chains to the commencing point in a swamp of the River Wannan.

CHATSWORTH, Counties of Villiers and Hampden, Parish unnamed.—Commencing at a point 1 chain due east from the south-east angle of suburban allotment 5 in township of Chatsworth; thence south 49 chains 65 links, more or less; thence west 80 chains; thence north 160 chains; thence east 80 chains; thence south 110 chains 35 links, more or less, to the point of commencement.

CHILTERN, County unnamed.—Commencing at the south-west corner, bearing east 1 chain, and thence south 31 chains from the south-east corner of country allotment 6; bounded on the west by a line bearing north, and crossing Black Dog Creek 80 chains; thence east 80 chains; thence south, crossing Dry Creek 80 chains; and thence west, crossing Black Dog Creek 80 chains to the commencing point.

CLARENDON, County of Grant, Parish of Clarendon.—Commencing at the north-east angle of portion 1, parish of Clarendon, being a point on the Back Creek; thence by the west side of Williamson street, bearing S. 60° 47' W. 37 chains 21 links, more or less, to Williamson's Creek; thence by the last named creek south-easterly and north-easterly to its junction with Back Creek, and by that creek westerly to the point of commencement.

COLAC, County of Poiworth, Parish of Elliminyt.—Commencing at the north-east angle of portion 6, section 9, in the parish of Elliminyt; thence on the west by a line bearing south 131 chains; on the south by a line bearing east 160 chains; on the east by a line bearing north 80 chains to the southern boundary of portion 8 of section 30, parish of Irewardra; thence west 1 chain, to western boundary of same portion; thence north 82 chains 70 links to Lake Colac; and on the north by the southern shore of Lake Colac to the commencing point.

COLERAINE, County of Dundas.—Commencing at the south-west angle of allotment 35, section 2, Coleraine suburbs; thence north 109 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence south 100 chains, crossing the Koroté Creek, to the south-east angle of allotment 10, section 1; thence east 80 chains to the point of commencement.

CORINELLA, County of Mornington.—Commencing at the north-east angle of section 69 A, parish of Corinella; thence north to Western Port Bay; thence by the shores of Western Port Bay westerly to Settlement Point; thence by the shore of Western Port Bay south-easterly to a point due west of the commencing point, and thence east to the point of commencement.

CRANBOURNE, County of Mornington, Parish of Cranbourne.—Commencing at the south-west angle of portion 16, parish of Cranbourne; thence east 80 chains; thence south 80 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence north 80 chains to the commencing point.

CRESSY.—Commencing at a point on the Woody Yallock Creek, being the north-east angle of allotment 13 in the parish of Wilgul, south; thence west to north-west angle of same; thence north to Williamson's pre-emptive section; thence by southern boundary of same to Woody Yallock Creek; thence by that creek north to Geo. Thompson's pre-emptive section; thence by southern boundary of same to north-west angle of portion 96 in the parish of Yurima; thence south to north-west angle of allotment A, portion 97, in the parish of Cressy; and thence west to the commencing point.

CROWLANDS, County unnamed, Parish of Crowlands.—Commencing at a point 1 chain west of north-west angle of allotment 1, section 4, in parish of Crowlands; thence south 80 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence north 80 chains; thence east 80 chains to the point of commencement.

DANDENONG.—Commencing at the south-east corner of portion 47 in the parish of Dandenong; bounded on the north by a line bearing west to the south-east corner of portion 34; on the west by a line bearing south to the south-west corner of the township reserve, 80 chains; on the south by a line bearing west to the south-east corner of said reserve, 81 chains; on the east by a line bearing north to the north-west corner of portion 19 in the parish of Eumemmerring, 40 chains; and again on the north by part of portion 18, bearing 9 chains 50 links, more or less, west to the Dandenong Creek; and on the east by that creek to the commencing point.

DARLEY (Bacchus Marsh), County of Bourke, Parishes of Korkuperrimul and Merrimu.—Commencing at a point being the south-west angle of allotment 1, section 18, in the parish of Merrimu; bounded on the east by a line bearing north to a point due east of the southern boundary line of portion A in the parish of Korkuperrimul; thence on the north by a line and the southern boundary of said portion A and a line due west to a point due north of the north-eastern angle of allotment C of section 16 in the parish of Korkuperrimul; thence on the west by a line due south to aforesaid angle; and thence on the south by a line due east to the commencing point aforesaid.

DARLINGTON.—Commencing at the south-east corner of allotment 2 of section 2 in the parish of Jellalabad, and bounded on the north by a line bearing east to the north-west angle of allotment 1 of section 14 in the parish of Darlington; on the

east by a line bearing south to the south-east corner of the township reserve; on the south by a line bearing west to the south-west angle of the said reserve, being the S.E. angle of allotment 7 of section 5; and on the west by a line bearing north to the commencing point.

DARTMOOR.—Commencing at the south-east corner of allotment 5 of section 2 in the parish of Dartmoor, and bounded on the east by a line bearing south to the south-east corner of the township reserve 110 chains; on the south by a line bearing west to the south-west corner of said reserve 100 chains; on the west by a line bearing north to the north-west corner of the township reserve 120 chains; on the north by a line bearing east to the Glenelg River; thence by the said river easterly to a point bearing west from the commencing point; and again on the north by a line bearing east to the commencing point.

DIGBY.—Commencing at the south-east corner of allotment 10 of section 1 in the parish of Digby, and bounded on the west by a line bearing north to the north-west angle of the township reserve 80 chains; on the north by a line bearing east to the north-east angle of said reserve 80 chains; and on the east by a line bearing south to the south-east angle of the aforesaid reserve 80 chains; and on the south by a line bearing west to the commencing point.

DONNYBROOK, County of Bourke, Parish of Kalkallo.—Commencing at the south-east angle of section 25 in parish of Kalkallo; thence south 80 chains to south-east angle of section 24 in same parish; thence east 40 chains; thence north 80 chains to southern boundary of section 26; thence west 40 chains to the point of commencement.

DROMANA, County of Mornington, Parish of Kangerong.—Commencing at the south-east angle of Burrell's pre-emptive section, parish of Kangerong; bounded on the south by a line bearing east 60 chains; on the east crossing a 1 chain road to the south-west angle of portion 5 of section 3; thence by the west boundary of portion 5, bearing north 81 chains; thence crossing a road 3 chains wide to the south angle of portion 1, section 1; thence by the west boundary of portion 1, bearing north 40 chains; thence by a line bearing north about 4 chains to the shore of Port Phillip Bay; on the north by the shore of Port Phillip Bay in a south-westerly direction to a point on the shore bearing N. 23° W. from the north angle of Burrell's pre-emptive section, parish of Kangerong; and on the west by the east boundary lines of this pre-emptive section, bearing S. 23° E. 33 chains 80 links and S. 4° E. 35 chains 50 links to commencing point.

DRYSDALE, County of Grant, Parish of Bellarine.—Commencing at the north-west angle of township reserve, being a point bearing west 1 chain from the south-west angle of portion 6, Bellarine Hills; thence east 80 chains; thence south 80 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence north 80 chains to the commencing point.

DUNKELD, County of Villiers.—Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the township, being the south-west angle of allotment 10, section 7, township of Dunkeld; thence south 29 chains 50 links, more or less; thence east 71 chains 12 links; thence north 90 chains; thence west 71 chains 12 links; and thence south 60 chains 50 links to the point of commencement.

ELMHURST, County unnamed, Parish of Glenpatrick.—Commencing at a point on the north-west boundary of the township, bearing N. 54° 45' W. 1 chain 50 links from the south-west angle of section 1, township of Elmhurst; thence by a line N. 35° 15' E. to the Wimmera River; thence by that river south-easterly to a point being the north-west angle of a reserve in section 4; thence by a line bearing S. 35° 15' W. 81 chains 30 links; thence N. 54° 45' W. 80 chains; thence N. 35° 15' E. to the point of commencement.

ELPHINSTONE, County of Talbot, Parish of Elphinstone.—Commencing at a point 1 chain and 50 links south and 50 links east of south-west angle of allotment 3, section 1, in the parish of Elphinstone; thence east 80 chains; thence south 80 chains; thence west 80 chains; thence north 80 chains to the point of commencement.

ELSTERNWICK, County of Bourke, Parish of Frahan.—Commencing at a point in Henderson street, bearing south 1 chain from the south-east angle of allotment 1, South Elwood; thence north by the west side of St. Kilda street and a line 80 chains; thence east 43 chains; thence south 80 chains; thence west 43 chains to the point of commencement.

ELTHAM, County of Evelyn, Parish of Nillumbik.—Commencing at the south-west angle of allotment 6, section 5, in the parish of Nillumbik; thence north 50 chains to south-east angle of allotment 12 of section 4 in same parish; thence west 80 chains; thence south 102 chains to the Yarra River, and by the Yarra River to the commencing point.

EMERALD, County of Mornington, Parish unnamed.—Commencing at a point bearing N. 39° E. 187 chains 80 links from the north-east angle of a reserve adjoining section 33, parish of Narree Worran; bounded on the west by a line bearing north 80 chains; on the north by a line bearing east 80 chains; on the east by a line bearing south 80 chains; and on the south, crossing the road to the Emerald Diggings, by a line bearing west 80 chains to commencing point.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR HENRY BARKLY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the session of parliament holden in the twenty-third and twenty-fourth years of Her present Majesty's reign, intituled, *An Act for regulating the Sale of Crown Lands and for other purposes*, it is amongst other things enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to proclaim that any Crown Lands in the vicinity of any town shall be a Common for the use of the inhabitants of such town, and all the inhabitants of such town and its vicinity shall, from the time of such proclamation, be entitled to depasture their cattle and horses on such Common, and such Common shall be called a "Town Common;" and it is further enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, or in case such Town Common shall be included within or adjoin the limits of any municipal district, then for the municipal council of such district, with the consent of the Governor in Council, to make rules and regulations for determining how many horses and cattle every such inhabitant shall be entitled to depasture on any Town Common: Now therefore I, Sir Henry Barkly, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim that the Crown Lands in the vicinity of the several towns hereinafter mentioned, comprised within the areas the description whereof is subjoined to the names of such towns respectively, shall be TOWNS COMMONS

within the meaning of the said Act, subject to such rules and regulations as shall be hereafter prescribed, for the use of the inhabitants of such towns respectively, that is to say:—

AVENEL.—Extent, 210 acres, more or less: Commencing at the north-east angle of the town reserve of Avenel; thence east 18 chains 50 links; thence south 113 chains 15 links; thence west 18 chains 50 links to the south-east angle of town reserve; thence by the east boundary of township north 113 chains 15 links to the commencing point.

BAIRNSDALE, District of Gipps Land, situate on the Mitchell River.—Extent, 96 acres, more or less: Commencing at the south-west angle of suburban lot No. 21, township of Bairnsdale; thence west to the Mitchell River; thence by that river south-easterly and southerly to a point due west of the south-west angle of suburban lot No. 16; thence east to the south-west angle of lot 16; thence north by the west sides of suburban lots 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 to the commencing point.
