THE GENERAL SESSIONS DISTRICTS OF KILMORE  
AND SANDHURST.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency SIR HENRY BARKLY, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Captain-General and Governor-in-Chief of the Colony of Victoria, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Lieutenant Governor and Legislative Council of the colony of Victoria, passed in the sixteenth year of the reign of Her present Majesty, intitled, *An Act to make provision for the better administration of Justice in the Courts of General Sessions in the Colony of Victoria*, it was amongst other things enacted, that Courts of General Sessions of the peace should be established and holden in certain places therein named, and such other places and districts within the said colony as the Lieutenant Governor thereof should appoint; and that it should be lawful for the Lieutenant Governor of the said colony from time to time to define and appoint by Proclamation the limits and boundaries of such places or districts within which all such courts should have jurisdiction respectively, and the places and times at which such courts should be holden, and such limits, districts, places and times respectively to revoke, alter, or vary, as the said Lieutenant Governor should think fit: And whereas by a Proclamation under the hand of the Governor and the seal of the colony, bearing date the twelfth day of July, in the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, the districts wherein the Courts of General Sessions holden at Kilmore and Sandhurst should have jurisdiction respectively were altered: And whereas it is expedient again to alter the districts assigned to the said courts respectively: Now therefore I, Sir Henry Barkly, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby revoke the said Proclamation; and, with the advice aforesaid, I do hereby declare and appoint that the said Courts of General Sessions shall have jurisdiction in and for the respective districts hereinafter described, that is to say:—

The Court of General Sessions of the peace holden at Kilmore shall have jurisdiction in and for the district of Kilmore, comprising all that portion of Victoria hereinafter described, viz.—Commencing at the source of the most eastern branch of the Broken River in the Great Dividing Range near Mount Buller, and thence by that river (excepting the township reserve of Benalla) to the Broken Creek; thence by that creek to its junction with the Back Creek; thence by a line northerly to the Murray; thence by the Rivers Murray and Goulburn to the junction of the Goulburn with Hughes's Creek; thence by a line south-westerly to the head of the McIvor Creek; thence by a line to the confluence of the McIvor and William's Creek; thence by William's Creek to the Great Dividing Range; and thence along the Great Dividing Range to the source of the Broken River, near Mount Buller aforesaid, being the commencing point.—(62.2204.)

The Court of General Sessions of the peace holden at Sandhurst shall have jurisdiction in and for the district of Sandhurst, comprising all that portion of Victoria hereinafter described, viz.—Commencing at the junction of the River Murray with

the River Goulburn; thence by the River Goulburn to its junction with Hughes's Creek; thence by a line south-west to the head of the McIvor Creek; thence by a line north-west to the junction of the Rivers Campaspe and Coliban; thence by the River Coliban, the Myrtle Creek, and the Mount Alexander Range to the most northern part of the county of Talbot north of Mount Alexander; thence by a line westerly to the River Loddon at its junction with McNeill's Creek; thence by the said river to its junction with an anabranch of the River Murray; thence by the said anabranch westerly to the south-east angle of the township of Castle Donnington; thence by the southern, western, and northern boundaries of the said township to the River Murray; thence by the said river easterly to the commencing point.—(62.2203.)

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twelfth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, and in the twenty-fifth year of Her Majesty's reign.
