BYE-LAW.-[23rd September, 1863.]

A T a meeting of the mining board of the mining district of Castlemaine, begun and holden at the Board Room, Camp, Castlemaine, in the said district, on the twenty-third day of September, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, it is ordained by the said board as follows, that is to say:—

Section 2. Extended claim for puddling, sluicing, and cementcrushing. Bye-law 5.—Whereas it is expedient to afford facilities
for and to encourage the investment of capital in re-working of
auriferous alluvial lands, and where the proposed mode of
working is such that an expensive race, or cutting, or timbering,
or machinery is necessary, every holder of a miners' right shall
be entitled to take up and hold a claim not exceeding ten acres
in extent; and he shall employ on, or in connection with said
claim, one person for every acre so held. No such claim under
this section shall be allowed except on ground which has been

Whereas by The Local Government Act, 1863, it is amongst other things enacted that in and for each original district within thirty days after the commencement of this Act, and in and for each single proclaimed district within fifteen days after the constitution thereof, the Governor in Council shall, and from time to time afterwards if it shall seem fit may on the application of the board of any such district, appoint a sufficient number of polling places for every such district at which the poll shall be taken at all elections held for the same, and may from time to time on the like application alter and vary the same: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth by this present Order appoint the polling places at which the poll shall be taken at all elections held for referred to in the second column of the schedule hereunto annexed, to be the polling place or polling places at which the poll shall be taken at all elections held for the original district mentioned in the first column of the same schedule opposite to the names of such polling place or polling places respectively, that is to say:—
