**GREETING—**

**W**HEREAS by divers commissions now in force certain persons have been assigned to keep the peace within the limits mentioned in such commissions: And whereas we are about to issue new commissions of the peace for limits different from those described in the said first-mentioned commissions, and in order that there may be no conflict of jurisdictions it is expedient that all existing justices of the peace should be superseded: Now, therefore, know ye that we do by these presents supersede, annul, and determine every commission now in force whereby any person or persons is or are assigned to keep the peace in our colony of Victoria or in any part thereof, and we do hereby discharge every such person or persons from the office of justice of the peace.

In testimony whereof we have caused these our letters to be made patent.

**MAGISTRATES FOR THE CENTRAL BAILLIWICK.**

VICTORIA, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland **QUEEN**, Defender of the Faith: To the several persons named in the schedule hereunto annexed—

**GREETING—**

**N**OW ye that we have, with the advice of our Executive Council, assigned you jointly and severally and every one of you, our Justices, to keep our peace within the Central Bailiwick, and to keep and cause to be kept all ordinances and laws for the good of the peace and the preservation of the same, and for the quiet rule and government of our people within our said Bailiwick, according to the force, form, and effect of the said ordinances and laws respectively, and to chastise and punish all offenders against the same. We have also, with the advice aforesaid, assigned you and every two or more of you, our Justices, to inquire the truth more fully by the oath of good and lawful men in that behalf chosen, tried

and sworn according to law, and by whom the truth of the matter shall be better known, of all and all manner of felonies, trespasses, and misdemeanors committed and done within our said Bailiwick, of which the Justices of our peace may or ought lawfully to inquire, and also to hear and determine all and singular the felonies, trespasses, and misdemeanors aforesaid, as in the like cases it has been accustomed or ought to be done, and all offenders for their offences aforesaid, according to the said ordinances and laws, to chastise and punish, and to exercise such further and other jurisdiction as by the laws in force in our said colony you may lawfully do. And therefore we command you and every of you that to keeping the peace, ordinances, and laws aforesaid you diligently apply yourselves, and that at certain days and places, which shall be duly and legally appointed for these purposes, into the felonies, trespasses, and misdemeanors aforesaid you make inquiries and all and singular the premises hear, and determine and perform and fulfil them in the aforesaid form, doing therein what to justice appertains, according to custom.

And we command, by the tenor of these presents, all our sheriffs whom it may concern that at certain days and places, which shall be made known to them respectively, they cause to come before you, or any two or more of you, as aforesaid, so many and such good and lawful men, by whom the truth of the matter in the premises shall be the better known and inquired into.

In testimony whereof we have caused these our letters to be made patent.

## MAGISTRATES FOR THE WESTERN BAILLIWICK.

VICTORIA, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland QUEEN, Defender of the Faith: To the several persons named in the schedule hereunto annexed—

## GREETING—

KNOW ye that we have, with the advice of our Executive Council, assigned you jointly and severally and every one of you, our Justices, to keep our peace within the Western Bailiwick, and to keep and cause to be kept all ordinances and laws for the good of the peace and the preservation of the same, and for the quiet rule and government of our people within our said Bailiwick, according to the force, form, and effect of the said ordinances and laws respectively, and to chastise and punish all offenders against the same. We have also, with the advice aforesaid, assigned you and every two or more of you, our Justices, to inquire the truth more fully by the oath of good and lawful men in that behalf chosen, tried and sworn according to law, and by whom the truth of the matter shall be better known, of all and all manner of felonies, trespasses, and misdemeanors committed and done within our said Bailiwick, of which the Justices of our peace may or ought lawfully to inquire, and also to hear and determine all and singular the felonies, trespasses, and misdemeanors aforesaid, as in the like cases it has been accustomed or ought to be done, and all offenders for their offences aforesaid, according to the said ordinances and laws, to chastise and punish, and to exercise such further and other jurisdiction as by the laws in force in our said colony you may lawfully do. And therefore we command you and every of you that to keeping the peace, ordinances, and laws aforesaid you diligently apply yourselves, and that at certain days and places, which shall be duly and legally appointed for these purposes, into the felonies, trespasses, and misdemeanors aforesaid you make inquiries and all and singular the premises hear, and determine and perform and fulfil them in the aforesaid form, doing therein what to justice appertains, according to custom.

And we command, by the tenor of these presents, all our sheriffs whom it may concern that at certain days and places, which shall be made known to them respectively, they cause to come before you, or any two or more of you, as aforesaid, so many and such good and lawful men, by whom the truth of the matter in the premises shall be the better known and inquired into.
