PROPOSED REVOCATION OF THE TEMPORARY RESERVATION OF LANDS.

IN pursuance of the provisions of *The Land Act 1869* (33 Vict. No. 360, § 6 and 9): Notice is hereby given that it is the intention of the Administrator of the Government, with the advice of the Executive Council, to *revoke* the temporary reservation of the lands hereinafter referred to after the expiration of four weeks from the first publication of notice in each instance, viz.:—

The following Notice was Gazetted 1^o on 19 March 1875, pursuant to Order of 18 March 1875.

ALBERT PARK.—The temporary reservation, by Order of the 22nd July 1862, of nine hundred and fifty-one acres, more or less, for a Park, to be called Albert Park, is about to be revoked.—(74.N.2790.)

The following Notice was Gazetted 1^o on 25 March 1875, pursuant to Order of 22 March 1875.

BUNINYONG (Shire of).—The area in the shire of Buninyong temporarily reserved by Order of the 24th October 1870, for the purpose of affording a supply of firewood, and diminished by Orders dated respectively the 9th December 1872, the 28th April and 13th October 1873, and the 18th May and 23rd December 1874, is about to be further diminished by revoking the temporary reservation of the portion thereof comprised within the boundaries hereinafter described, viz.:—Four acres two roods eight perches, county of Grenville, parish of Lynchfield: Commencing at a point on the west side of the Ballarat and Rokewood road bearing S. 23° 9' W. thirteen chains eighty-three links and S. 15° 7' W. fifteen chains two links from the south-east angle of Edward Kearney's 49th section block No. 560; bounded thence by the said road bearing S. 15° 7' W. six chains fifty links; and thence by roads bearing respectively N. 74° 53' W. seven chains, N. 15° 7' E. six chains fifty links, and S. 74° 53' E. seven chains to the point of commencement.—(N.R.389.)
