BANK HOLIDAYS AT WARRNAMBOOL AND MURCHISON.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency SIR GEORGE FERGUSON BOWEN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of *The Bank Holidays Act 1873*, I, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint the undermentioned days special days to be observed as Bank Holidays at Warrnambool and Murchison, that is to say:—

AT WARRNAMBOOL, WEDNESDAY THE 10TH OF OCTOBER INSTANT,
AT MURCHISON, THURSDAY THE 18TH OF OCTOBER INSTANT.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this eighth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, and in the forty-first year of Her Majesty's reign.
