APPOINTMENTS TO NAVAL CADETSHIPS.

WITH reference to previous notices in the *Victoria Government Gazette* respecting the nomination to the Naval Cadetships annually placed by the Imperial Government at the disposal of the Governors of the principal colonies for the sons of colonists, His Excellency the Governor of Victoria directs it to, be notified that he will nominate the candidate, who, being otherwise eligible, in all respects, according to the Admiralty Regulations, shall pass the best competitive examination.

The subjects for examination will be those prescribed in the Regulations aforesaid.—See the *Victoria Government Gazette* of 11th June 1875, No. 42.

It is requested that the parents or guardians of candidates will send their applications to the Private Secretary, Government House, Melbourne, on or before the 24th day of December 1877. The certificates of birth, good conduct, and good health required by the Regulations must accompany each application.
