BANK HOLIDAYS, BEECHWORTH AND PORTLAND.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir GEORGE FERGUSON BOWEN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of *The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I*, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint the undermentioned days as special days to be observed as Bank Holidays, viz. :—

FRIDAY THE 16TH OF MARCH INSTANT,
to be observed as a Bank Holiday within the United Shire of Beechworth.

SATURDAY THE 17TH OF MARCH INSTANT,
to be observed as a Bank Holiday within the Borough of Portland.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this thirteenth day of March, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, and in the fortieth year of Her Majesty's reign.
