HALF BANK-HOLIDAY IN GEELONG.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir GEORGE FERGUSON BOWEN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

**I**N pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of *The Bank Holidays Act 1873*, I, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint

From the hour of TWELVE O'CLOCK NOON ON FRIDAY THE 26TH OF JANUARY INSTANT to be observed as a Bank Holiday in Geelong.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twenty-fourth day of January, in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, and in the fortieth year of Her Majesty's reign.
