BANK HOLIDAY IN MELBOURNE AND SUBURBS AND KILMORE.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir GEORGE FERGUSON BOWEN, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, and Vice-Admiral of the same, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of *The Bank Holidays Act 1873*, I, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY THE 2ND OF JANUARY NEXT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday in the City of Melbourne and the surrounding Municipalities from the hour of Twelve noon; also a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Kilmore.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this thirty-first day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, and in the forty-second year of Her Majesty's reign.
