BANK HOLIDAYS AT DIVERS PLACES.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Most Honorable George Augustus Constantine, Marquis of Normanby, Earl of Mulgrave, Viscount Normanby, and Baron Mulgrave of Mulgrave, all in the County of York, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; and Baron Mulgrave of New Ross, in the County of Wexford, in the Peerage of Ireland; a Member of Her Majesty's Most Honorable Privy Council; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria, and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I the Governor of Victoria, do hereby revoke so much of a former Proclamation, bearing date the 13th instant, as relates to the appointment of a Bank Holiday on the $29 \mathrm{th}$ instant at Horsham, Murtoa, and Natimuk ; and I do by this my Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY THE 23RD OF OCTOBER INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday at Chunes;

FRIDAY THE 24TH OF OCTOBER INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Clunes, Creswick, and Maryborough and District;

TUESDAY THE 28TH OF OCTOBER INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Horsham, Minyip, Murtoa, Natimuk, Rupanyup, and St. Arnaud;

Wednesday the 29th of October instant

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Creswick, and Bank Half-Holiday at Inglewood from the hour of Twelve noon; THURSDAY THE 30TH OF OCTOBER INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday at Inglewood, from the hour of Twelve noon;

FRIDAY THE 31ST OF OCTOBER INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday in the City and Town of Ballarat and at Sebastopol.
