IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of *The Public Service Act 1883, I*, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY THE 3RD DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Borough of St. Kilda;

WEDNESDAY THE 9TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Borough of Creswick, and as a Public Half-Holiday at Sale and within the Shire of Bairnsdale, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon;

THURSDAY THE 10TH AND FRIDAY THE 11TH DAYS OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as Public Holidays at Beaufort, Minyip, and Rupanyup, and as Public Half-Holidays at Murtoa, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day;

MONDAY THE 14TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Romsey;

WEDNESDAY THE 16TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Holiday at Talbot;

WEDNESDAY THE 16TH AND THURSDAY THE 17TH DAYS OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as Public Half-Holidays at Sale, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon;

THURSDAY THE 17TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the South Riding of the Shire of St. Arnaud;

FRIDAY THE 18TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Half-Holiday within the South Riding of the Shire of St. Arnaud, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon;

TUESDAY THE 22ND DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Seymour;

THURSDAY THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT

to be observed as a Public Holiday at Nagambie, and within the Shires of Bairnsdale and Benalla.

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Minyip, Murtoa, Rupanyup, and Warracknabeal;

WEDNESDAY THE 9TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday within the Borough of Creswick, and as a Bank Half-Holiday at Sale and within the Shire of Bairnsdale, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon;

THURSDAY THE 10TH AND FRIDAY THE 11TH DAYS OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

to be special days to be observed as Bank Holidays at Beaufort, Minyip, Rupanyup, and Warracknabeal; and as Bank Half-Holidays at Murtoa, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day;

MONDAY THE 14TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday within the Shire of Romsey;

WEDNESDAY THE 16TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

FRIDAY THE 18TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday within the South Riding of the Shire of St. Arnaud, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon;

TUESDAY THE 22ND DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday within the Shire of Seymour;

THURSDAY THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT

a special day to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Nagambie, and within the Shires of Bairnsdale and Benalla.
