### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Henry Brougham Loch, Knight Com-mander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of The Public Service Act 1883, and the fifth section of The Bank Holidays Act 1873, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint Proclamation appoint

Wednesday the 15th day of June instant to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Borough of Daylesford;

THURSDAY THE 23RD DAY OF JUNE INSTANT to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Mansfield, and within the Borough of Northcote;

FRIDAY THE 1ST DAY OF JULY NEXT to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shire of Bairnsdale.
