PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir HENRY BROUGHAM LOCH, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of *The Public Service Act 1883*, and the fifth section of *The Bank Holidays Act 1873*, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY THE 30TH DAY OF JUNE INSTANT
to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shires of Narracan and Traralgon;

FRIDAY THE 1ST AND MONDAY THE 4TH DAYS OF JULY NEXT
to be observed as Public and Bank Half-Holidays within the Shire of Rodney, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day;

THURSDAY THE 7TH DAY OF JULY NEXT
to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Romsey;

WEDNESDAY THE 3RD DAY OF AUGUST NEXT
to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Rutherglen;

THURSDAY THE 4TH DAY OF AUGUST NEXT
to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Swan Hill.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twenty-ninth day of June, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, and in the fifty-first year of Her Majesty's reign.
