AGRICULTURAL STATISTICS.

MEMORANDUM.—At the early date at which the Agricultural Statistics are collected, it is impossible to obtain a reliable estimate of the produce of Hops, Tobacco, or Vines. Most of the growers, however, have since sent in returns in compliance with circulars addressed to them by the Government Statist. In cases where these circulars have not been responded to, the produce has been estimated according to the average yield of the same crops prevailing in the district.

These particulars relate to Municipalities in which there was only one grower of the crops referred to. They have been combined, in order that publicity might not be given to the operations of the individual cultivator. The Shires in which there was only one grower of Hops were Berwick, Glenelg, Howqua, Narracan, Phillip Island, Swan Hill, Traralgon, Warragul, and Warrnambool; those in which there was only one grower of Tobacco were Bairnsdale, Benalla, Chiltern, and North Ovens; and those in which there was only one grower of Vines were Bacchus Marsh, Creswick, Flinders and Kangerang, Gisborne, Glenelg, Glenlyon, Grenville, Lexton, Lowan, Mount Rouse, Whittlesea, Wyndham, and Yea; also the following Towns and Boroughs, Brighton, Brunswick, Chewton, Clunes, Echuca, Hawthorn, Maryborough, Stawell, and Talbot.
