PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir HENRY BROUGHAM LOCH, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the eighty-eighth section of *The Public Service Act 1833*, and in the fifth section of *The Bank Holidays Act 1873*, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

WEDNESDAY THE 10TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Half-Holiday at Ararat, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon ;

WEDNESDAY THE 17TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday within the Shire of Kowree ;

WEDNESDAY THE 24TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT

to be observed as a Public and Bank Holiday at Boort.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this eighth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, and in the fifty-first year of Her Majesty's reign.
